- HANDREARING -

by M. Allmark

This article is written to help the novice breeder; established kennels have all at one time or another had to hand rear a litter and need no advice from me. Unfortunately, although the majority of Bull Terriers are usually excellent mothers, now and again we get the bitch who either can not or will not feed her puppies, and to be forewarned is to be forearmed.

Warmth is essential for new born pups. We wrap a hot water bottle in a towel and put it into a cardboard carton just big enough to fit it and keep this close to a gas or electric fire night and day.

The formula I have used for years with great success is as follows;-

4ozs. Evaporated Milk

4ozs Water

1 Egg Yolk

20 drops of Pentavite (infant)

1 teaspoon Glucose

Mix well and put through a fine sieve. Use a baby bottle or a medicine bottle. As a new puppy can not suck very strongly you may have to enlarge the hole in the teat. I have found a red hot needle is right for the job.

After the feed gently rub the lower tummy with cotton-wool dipped in warm water. This helps the pup to evacuate and also bring up the wind. It is most important that the puppy has a bowel movement at least twice a day.

For the first couple of days feed at two and a half hour intervals, be careful not to overfeed. I make the last feed at 11.30 p.m. and the first morning feed at 5.00 a.m., so that both you and the pups get a good nights rest.

After the first four days go on to three hourly feeds, then four hourly at ten days. Keep the pups on the formula until their eyes are open, then on to a sloppy mixture of the formula and baby Farex, plus a quarter of a teaspoonful of scraped beef. At first you will have to put this directly into the mouth, after the first couple of meat feeds you will find your fingers almost disappear too!

I know this sound an awful lot of work, but to see your puppies grow fat and healthy is reward enough.

I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to ask for your help.

Animals Australia's investigations have revealed a number of Bull Terrier puppies for sale by pet shops. Customers are buying them based on a "cuteness factor" and are unlikely to understand or be able to address the needs of the breed.

We are currently working with several members of the Victorian ALP on a ban of sales of all puppies from pet shops and believe we are close to securing a commitment ahead of the election in November.

Support from groups such as yourselves at this time is crucial and therefore, I am hoping you could write to the Victorian ALP, expressing your support for a ban. A letter from a club such as yours would be of great assistance.

Frosty Treats for your Pooch



Frozen Pops

Ingredients

1/4 cup Peanut Butter
2 cups Strawberries, chopped (frozen or fresh)
1/2 cup Blueberries (frozen or fresh)
1 3/4 cup plain Yogurt, divided
4 Rawhide Sticks

First Layer

1/4 cup Peanut Butter
3/4 cup plain Yogurt
Add peanut butter and yogurt to a blender or food processor and blend until smooth

Second Layer

2 cups Strawberries, chopped
1/4 cup plain Yogurt
Add strawberries and yogurt to a blender or food processor and blend until smooth

Third Layer

1/2 cup Blueberries
3/4 cup plain Yogurt
Mix blueberries and yogurt

Directions

1. Pour an inch or so of your first layer mixture into the bottom of each cup.
 2. Allow to freeze for 30 minutes, and insert your rawhide stick.
 3. Repeat pouring the layers, allowing them to set 30 minutes in between, until they are all used.
 4. Freeze for 8 hours to allow them to fully set.
 5. Run warm water around the mold to remove the Popsicle.
- Makes 4 popsicles.



Frozen Coconut Mango & Pineapple Treats

Ingredients

1/2 cup crushed Pineapple
1 ripe Banana
2 tablespoons Coconut Oil
1/4 cup dried Fruit (Mango, pineapple and banana. Make sure the fruit is dog safe) Can use fresh cut up in small pieces.

Directions

1. Blend the pineapple, banana and coconut oil until smooth.
2. Divide the dried fruit into the bottom of your molds and pour the blended mixture over them.
3. Allow the treats to freeze for up to eight hours, to allow them to fully set.
4. Run warm water around the mold to remove.
