

## Changed restrictions for Gazebos under power lines

Exhibitors please be advised that temporary structures (gazebos/tents) may now be erected under the power lines as long as they do not go over the height limit of 2.5 metres and are earthed.

Without temporary structures being earthed there is an electrical shock risk. Smaller metallic tent frames/gazebos installed at EPIC under or near the HV overheads, must have metallic ends in direct contact with the finished ground level. No insulating caps or feet or concrete bases are to remain between the temporary structure's framing and metal parts that are contact with the ground. Many tents/gazebos for example have moulded plastic caps for neatness on the ends of metal tubular framework. Gazebos such as this must not be used.

The intent is to electrically ground metallic framing by having all metallic frame ends in contact with the soil. This establishes a safe practice to mitigate electric shock.
