oured dog. Mouth lets him down, well filled head. Shorter in back to no 1. Adequate bone. Not quite m of stifle of his brother. He enjoyed his day out.

No 4: Shirvin Slice of Heaven

dog. Quite a big boy for age. Good length of muzzle with a gentle slope from ears to tip of nose. correct. Level top line, good bone and turn of stifle. movement going away hard to access. Quite a al, quite the clown.

No 6: Cinak Sweet Sensation

Black brindle dog. Nicely filled head. Mouth not correct. Short back, good bone. Straight front. Moves both ways: Reserve Challenge Dog.

No 5: Keory Kristopher

dog with red eye patch. Lacks the fill in head of no 1 though has good length of head, short back, bone for size of dog.

No 7: Ch Jotadabull Juggernaut

Brindle. Good length of head. Bone adequate. Close contest with second place getter, only missing cause of length of back.

No 8: Rijiaca Man In Black

our dog. Nice gentle arc to head but with slight dip between the eyes. Slight mouth problem. Short Good bone. Moved well in both directions



Class 11

1st No 9: Tiponya Im All That

Brindle dog. Well filled and turned head. Slight mouth problem. Short back. Good Bone. Straight front. Moves well both ways: Challenge Dog – Best of Breed

2nd No 10: Bullamakanka Showtime

Strong masculine white. Not the strength of head of no 1. Front not his greatest glory and his movement suffers for it. Well presented.

Class 1a

1st No 13: Missigai Music Makes Me

Well presented white girl. Gentle arc with correct mouth and good strength of under jaw. Bone adequate for size. Short back. Moves nicely both ways. A promising one for the future.

2nd No 12: Bullamakanka Riccadonna

Young black & white. 4 months old, still quite the baby. Smaller than no 1. Gentle arc to head, no teeth to speak of. A shade long in back. She enjoyed her day out.

Class 3a

1st No 16: Delphinus Miss B Havin

White girl, still with a lot of ticking in the coat. Good head with a gentle slope. Short in back with good lay of shoulder. Would like to see more turn of stifle, though she moved well both ways.

2nd No 15: Buxston Soul Seduction

Bigger girl, losing to no 1 on length of body and upright shoulder.

Class 4a

1st No 17: Rijiaca Mystic River

Rich red brindle & white. Good head with gentle arc. Mouth problem. Broad chest, gun barrel front. Short back with level top line. Lovely hindquarters, moves well both ways. A bit uptight today though her quality still shows through. : Challenge Bitch - Reserve BoB

2nd No 18: Bullamakanka Gobstopper

Tricolour. Feminine quality all through. Good head with in-standing canine which let her down today. She moved adequately.

3rd No 19: Rijiaca Athena

White. Lacks the head of 1 & 2. Upright in Shoulder, long in back. I would like to see more upper arm.



Class 5a

1st No 20: Taffnbull Naughty Butnice

Lovely Black Brindle & White. Stunning head with tiny eye for a coloured. Slight mouth fault. Good depth of chest. Front straight, good lay of shoulder. I would like to see a shorter back. Moved only fairly today which cost her the challenge . : Reserve Challenge Bitch.

Class 11a

1st No 21: Rijiaca Spot O Gold

White girl. Quality head with gentle slope. Good make and shape. Straight front with level top line. Moves close behind.

White dog. He was a little bigger than "standard" height. Correct Mouth. With an average head. Rather short in upper arm. Moved close both ways.
