MINIATURE BULL TERRIERS - DOGS

Class 1

1. Frith's **Hulia Little Harry** – Cobby brindle and white with a nice short back and big, round bone. Lovely long, clean head with good profile and fill. Moved well for a pup. **Best Baby Puppy in Breed and Best Baby Puppy in Show**
2. Frith's **Hulia Little Mo** – Great head with arching profile and tons of fill; small, well-placed eye. Good bone and a short back, unfortunately, did not want to move a single step.
3. Sutcliffe's **Balgay Spongebob Squarepants** – Brindle and white with nice length to his head with a good profile and adequate fill. A tad long in back, which did not hold well on the move.

Class 3

1. Lachmund & Harmon's **Bullalaris Fall Out Boy** – Big white dog with a smooth, gentle profile with loads of fill and a correct bite. Nice, tiny eye. Good bone with a strong forechest, moved a bit close in front, decent rear movement. **Best Puppy**

Class 4

1. Stewart's **Speiread Diablo Grande Gold** – White with black-brindle ears and eyepatch. Upstanding terrier type with a good profile and decent fill. Nice eye. Front movement good, rear a bit loose. A bit light in weight on the day. **Best Junior**

Class 5

1. Schofield's **Stardom Gold Rush** – Cobby brindle and white with nice length and profile to his head. Great fill, level bite and a wicked little eye. Tremendous expression and ear set. Great front construction with resulting reach, nice, wide rear movement with good angulation. **Best Intermediate in Breed, Reserve Dog C.C. and Best Intermediate in Show**
2. Manna's **CH Chaylotte Charming** – Smooth, gentle profile with adequate fill. Nice shoulder and good rear angulation, a bit too much roach in the topline.

Class 10

1. Craven's **Bullactiv Two Moon** – Brindle and white with a very nice profile and length of head. Great fill and the tiniest of eyes gave the lad great expression. Correct bite. Good bone, nice layback of shoulder, a tad long in back, moved well both ways. **Best Australian Bred**
2. Frith's **Hulia Charmer** – Terrier-type with nice lines. Good profile, decent fill with a well-shaped eye. Correct bite. Moved smoothly around the ring.
3. Zullo's **Bullactiv Ghost Warrior** – Good bone and substance to this boy. Very nice head with good profile and fill. Mouth under. A bit long in back with a dip in the topline

Class 11

1. Zullo's **GR CH Bullactiv Spotted Owl** – Big brindle and white boy. Long, arched profile with loads of fill right to the tip of his muzzle. Tiny eye and great earset led to a wicked expression. Level bite. Beautiful arched neck blended perfectly into the withers, good layback of shoulder and a well-angulated rear led to great movement front and rear. Showed phenomenally. **Best Open, Dog C.C. and Best of Breed**

MINIATURE BULL TERRIERS – BITCHES

Class 3A

1. Knis' **Speiread IGotcha Bling** – Nicely balanced all-white girl with good bone and substance. Nice profile, good fill under the eye and a correct bite. Moved okay in front, a bit close in the rear.

Class 5A

1. Frith's **Hulia Angel Hand** – A nice, typey red and white; great compact proportions. Very nice head with arched profile, good fill and a correct bite. She has a very nice forechest with good substance and spring of rib. Perfect front and strong rear movement completed the picture. **Bitch C.C.**
2. Knis' **Speiread MP Twiddle Bug** – Brindle and white with a very arched profile, well placed, small eye and a correct bite. Nice, wide rear with very good drive, a bit close in front and a tad long in back. **Reserve Bitch C.C.**

Class 10A

1. Zullo's **Bullactive Apache Teardrop** – Black-brindle with a good profile and adequate fill. Correct mouth. A bit high-stationed in the rear. Presented well and moved around the ring in easy strides.

Class 11A

1. Sutcliffe's **Semajon Miss Abbey** – Big brindle and white girl with very good bone and substance. She has a nice, long arched profile with good fill; reverse scissors bite. Constructed well with a strong forechest, nice layback of shoulder and good rear angulation.
2. Selden's **Bullwhip Lady Hawk** – Pretty girl with a good profile and fill under the eyes. Beautiful arched neck blending nicely into the withers. Movement was a bit close in front.

BULL TERRIERS – DOGS

Class 1

1. Bathgate's **Tenaz All Fired Up** – Upstanding black-brindle boy with good bone and a nice, smooth profile with good fill and a correct bite. Small eye contributed to a very good expression. Front was a bit loose, though he is young. Rear had nice angulation and hip set, with resulting good movement.
2. Wiseman's **Bulroarus Naughty Nev** – Nicely balanced youngster with a good profile and correct bite. Good expression when he used his ears. He has a good forechest, well-let down rear with a nice, short hock.
3. Frith's **Hulia Sugar Man** – Very typey, cobby boy. Nice bone and substance, not quite the head quality of nos. 1 and 2.

Class 2

1. Sutcliffe's **Semajon Son of Bruce** – Upstanding terrier type with very nice lines and good expression. Nicely turned profile with a good bite. Good length of neck leading into a nice short back with a straight topline with the nice, slight rise over the croup. Good angulation, will benefit with a tad more substance as he matures.
2. Kaposi's **Chopsbullis Mean Streak** – Great bone on this boy with good layback of shoulder and great reach on the move. Slight break in profile and a tad long in back.

Class 3

1. Frith's **Hulia Fortune Cookie** – Cobby and square red smut with a really nice head, smooth profile with great fill all the way down the muzzle. Correct bite. Tiny little eyes helped give wonderful expression. Nice bone and substance, good deep chest and a short back . A bit straight in the stifle.

Class 4

1. Bathgate's **Tenaz High Voltage** – Upstanding red and white with great lines, balance and proportion. Long, clean profile, good fill and a correct bite. Nicely arched neck leading into a straight topline which he held on the move. Good bone and correct substance; he was nicely muscled, in great condition with no extra weight. Good chest and front assembly and good angulation led to good reach and drive on the move. **Dog C.C., Best Junior in Breed and Best Junior in Show, Best of Breed and Best in Show**
2. Schofield's **Stardom Demons Disciple** – Nice, short back with good forechest and depth of brisket. Nice profile with good fill. Well let-down hocks, moved well in front, rear movement not his forte.
3. Sarajeni Kennels **Sarajeni XC Lent** – Big brindle and white boy with good bone and substance. Short, arched profile with good fill, undershot bite. Movement was a bit loose, but should tighten up with age as he is still a young dog.

Class 5

1. Long's **Kjong Hammer Time** – Cobby, white dog, good bone and perhaps a bit too much substance. Nicely turned head, good fill and a perfect bite. Very nice eye and expression. Moved well in front and with good drive in the rear. **Best Intermediate in Breed**
2. Frith's **Hulia Jumping Jack Flash** – Black-brinde with a good profile and adequate fill, good expression. Decent bone and substance, moved freely around the ring.

Class 10

1. Wiseman's **Bulroarus Womaniser** – Well balanced white dog with a long, clean profile and the fill under his eye was one of the best of the day. Moved true both front and rear with good reach and drive, short back with straight topline which he held on the move. When he pulled up he was quite a nice picture. **Best Australian Bred in Breed, Reserve Dog C.C. and Best Australian Bred in Show**
2. Prott's **Bulrrush Gilbert of Putney** – Big, upstanding boy with beautiful lines and a wide, filled head and a smooth but rather flat profile. Good looking boy, was not thrilled about moving on the day.
3. Brasshead Kennels/Carter **CH Brasshead Gothic Clown** – Black-brindle and white, nicely turned profile with good expression. Decent bone with a deep chest. Movement was fluid around the ring.

Bull Terriers – Bitches

Class 1A

1. Hellofabull Kennels **Hellofabull Dan Sin Queen** – Pretty white puppy with a smooth profile, good expression and a correct bite. Nice short back with beautiful lines. She bunny-hopped around the ring well; it was cute – she’s a puppy! **Best Baby Puppy in Breed**
2. Bathgate’s **Tenaz Sizzlin Hot** – Brindle and white with a nicely turned profile, small eye and good expression with well-set ears. Good bone, a bit long in back.

Class 2A

1. Cross’ **Missigai Misty Maid Cleo** – Upstanding brindle and white with beautiful, flowing lines. Long, well-arched profile, nice little eye with a correct bite. Decent bone with good substance, good lay of shoulder, moved out well. **Best Minor Puppy in Breed and Best Minor Puppy in Show**
2. 2.Kaposi’s **Chopsbullis Kissin Dynamite** – Nicely arched profile and good expression. Happy showgirl who moved well around the ring.
3. Healand’s **Shirvin Sha Boom** – Lovely cobby bitch with nice bone and substance, deep brisket and a wide, filled head. Unfortunately on the day, she was not a “happy camper.”

Class 3A

1. Sarajeni Kennels **Monkromony Hot Gossip** – Nice typey, cobby white girl. Beautiful wide head with well-turned profile, good eye and expression, correct bite. Strong forechest with a deep brisket. Good layback of shoulder, straight topline which she held on the move, well let-down hocks, had good reach and drive while moving around the ring. **Best Puppy in Breed, Reserve Bitch C.C. and Best Puppy in Show**
2. Woodsell’s **Jewelbull Lucifers Angel** – Very elegant, upstanding bitch with beautiful lines. Long, arched profile, decent fill with a nice, small eye. Moved well both front and rear, topline gave way a bit on the move.
3. Dougan’s **Monkromony Crocodile Tears** – Very typey with a wide, filled head, well-arched profile and a good bite. Good bone, nice forechest and brisket, carrying a bit too much weight on the day.

Class 4A

1. Healand's **Shirvin Queen of the Blues** –Cobby and typey black-brindle with a short back, good bone and substance, and a wide, completely filled-up head. Beautiful small eye and ears right on top gave her a wonderful expression. Correct bite. Good lay back of shoulder and a well let-down rear led to nice each and drive around the ring. **Bitch C.C., Runner-Up Best of Breed and Runner-Up Best in Show**
2. Healand's **Shirvin Quando Quando** – Nice length and scope with a really “cranked over” profile. A bit light in bone and substance, but constructed very well and moved well in all directions.
3. Wiseman's **Bulroarus Enteyesing** – Pleasing head with a good profile and fill. Good bone with a nice forechest, carrying a tad too much weight. Constructed well, moved with drive and purpose.

Class 5A

1. Hellobabull Kennels **Hellobabull Girl Gone Wild** –Very elegant and upstanding black-brindle and white with a beautiful profile and nice length of neck blending perfectly into the withers. Nice, short back, well-angulated rear, nicely developed chest and brisket.
2. Sutcliffe's **Brasshead Ruver Queen** – Big white girl with good profile and fill and a very nice expression. Good bone and too much substance, a bit of a dip behind the withers.
3. Bathgate's **Tenaz Struttin Her Stuff** – Pretty girl with nice proportion. Clean, arched profile with good fill, good bone and forechest, not real enthusiastic on the day.

Class 10A

1. Kaposi's **CH Bulroarus Do or Die** – White with a nice, gentle profile, decent fill and good expression. Mouth correct. Moved well, a tad long in back.

Class 11A

1. Healand's **Shirvin Jennefer Juniper** – Nice, typey white bitch with smooth profile and really good fill through the muzzle. When she perked up, very good expression. Well let-down rear, good shoulder, moved well front and rear. **Best Open in Breed and Best Open in Show**
2. Bathgate's **CH Satori Sheez Set to Sizzle** – Upstanding black-brindle and white with a long, arched profile, great little eyes and ears right on top which led to a terrific expression. A bit long in back, and would like more width in front.
