The trophies, dinner & camaraderie were truly memorable. I personally would like to thank the exhibitors who accepted my opinions on the day with grace. I judged many lovely dogs and several decisions were exceptionally close.

BULL TERRIER

Class 3 - Puppy Dog

PARIBEN PAPER CUT

White dog with small dark eyes. Ears, though a little large at this stage, are well set combining to impart that varminty expression. Would like a little more length to head, but well filled. Strong bone in front & powerful forechest. Short back with good shape to the croup. Immaturity evident on his loose pasterns & movement.

Class 5 - Intermediate Dog

CH. CHOPSBULLIS GENTLEMAN JACK

Tricolour dog with impressive head profile- great length. Ears set & carried well. Correct mouth. Strong neck, round bone. A tad more fore angulation would shorten his back somewhat. Well turned in rear & moved with a jaunty air.

Class 10 - Australian Bred Dog

BULROARUS ALTER EGO

Compact white dog presenting as an impressive package. Reasonable profile well filled under the eye. Dark small eye with correct mouth. Good quality bone with tight cat feet. Although he looks compact, he was actually a little long in coupling. Front movement showed some looseness in pastern, rear movement square.

Class 1a - Baby Puppy Bitch

BULROARUS SPICY MARTINI(AI)

A strong, well packed baby with a lovely profile & filled head. Slight mouth fault. Good depth of forechest. Compact with a well-turned stifle.

Class 2a - Minor Puppy Bitch

CHOPSBULLIS KYLIE MINOGE

White bitch with good length & shape to head- perhaps a tad flat on the skull. Dark eye & large ears- she needs to grow into them! Slight mouth fault. Good bone for her size but her construction is very loose due to immaturity. Difficult to assess today as she had the naughtiness in her.

Class 3a - Puppy Bitch

PARIBEN PROPAGANDA

Very pretty white bitch who still has some maturing to do. Excellent shape & length of head- just needs a little more of it! Correct mouth, lovely eye shape. Good quality round straight bone. Made quite nicely, but her movement showed her immaturity, with slight looseness of pasterns. Will watch her progress!

Class 4a - Junior Bitch

JONLI HALO ON FIRE (AI)

Substantial red bitch. Pretty shape of head with good length. Quite well filled & correct mouth. Her expression was a tad kind. Deep chest with tight feet. Fore angulation could be better, which affected her topline- causing her to dip slightly. Driving rear movement from a well-turned stifle.

Class 5a - Intermediate Bitch

YANDOMIR L ECLISSE

White bitch with big profile. Well filled under the eye, which was small & dark. A smaller ear would have fully completed the expression. Straight front, good feet. I would prefer better angulation of her fore- and, as often happens, this lengthened her back. Good turn of stifle & low set tail. Did not want to play the walking game today!

Class 10a - Australian Bred Bitch

BULLPATCHY RHYTHM N BLUES(AI)

Short cobby brindle bitch showing good head qualities- to be picky, could have a little more around muzzle. Small dark eye matched with small ears right on top of her head imparted excellent expression. Straight round bone in front- tight feet. Compact shapely body with turn of stifle. A little looseness in the hock area on the move.

CH. CHOPSBULLIS MOJITO

White bitch with excellent length of head and gradual curve to her profile. Dark eye though could be a little smaller. Correct bone & front, though not the bone to size ratio of number 1. Lovely neck, a little long in coupling. Moved with typical jaunty air.

Class 11a - Open Bitch

CH. STARDOM MERLOT TIPPED DIAMON

Stylish white bitch with lovely outline- unfortunately she has been on a good paddock, so, much of that outline was hidden. Head of pleasing profile & length, could have a smidge more fill to balance. Eye of good shape though a little light. Good fore angulation with excellent depth of forechest. Could be closer coupled. Stifle turned well & she moved well off it.

BULL TERRIER MINIATURE

Class 1 - Baby Puppy Dog

DEROYALE RHUGAR DA KING(AI)

Attractive red pup- well filled head of good shape. Dark eye. Straight in front with developing forechest. Fore angulation could be marginally better, which subsequently shortens his neck. Good topline, tail set a tad high.

KAHMINS THE WIZARD

Very attractive solid brindle Pleasing profile but not quite the fill of number 1. Tight mouth at this stage. Reachy neck with good bone in front. Puppy looseness saw him a little high in rear on the move.

Class 3 - Puppy Dog

STARMIN EGYPTIAN PRINCE

Good size with pleasing length of head though a little plain in profile. Dark eye. Small ears though set a little wide. Straight front, tight cat feet. He appeared very nervous today so he was difficult to assess fully.

Class 4 - Junior Dog

CH. ECBULLIES DIAMONDSRAGIRLSBSF

Black brindle with lovely length of head. Pleasing unbroken profile with a dark but kind eye. Good bone for his size, fore angulation was also pleasing. Unfortunately, there were some problems with size & mouth.

Class 5 - Intermediate Dog

CH. STARMIN SOUL REAVER

Fawn dog with well filled & turned head. Dark eye but a little kind. Small ears, set could be more on top of head. Good quality bone

CH LILBUL BILLY BUTTON WILDFLOWER

Attractive brindle dog with pleasing length of head, but could do with more fill under the eye. Dark eye, could be a better shape. Straight front with tight cat feet. Neck flowed nicely in to topline. Rear could have better angulation. He was lacking in substance for my preference.

Class 10 - Australian Bred Dog

KAHMINS CIRCUS CIRCUS

Well packed head, though a little more length would balance it better. Dark eye but kind expression. Ears a little large. Straight bone in front. A tad more neck would see him balance a bit more. Movement displayed cow hocks. Beautifully presented.

Class 11 - Open Dog

A2O CH C.I.B. GRAND. CH. LLUBINIM ZEKE AND DESTROY

Tri colour dog of quality & strength. Perhaps a little tall, but many virtues to overcome this today. Well packed shapely head with dark eye & correct mouth. Strong bone, could be a bit more reachy in neck. Lovely outline & shape.

CHRYSAISS SILENT ASSASSIN

White dog of correct height. Strong skull area but could have a little more power around muzzle. Dark small eye with small ears gave a pleasing varminty expression. Cobby. Moved a little wide in front today. Overall quality dog- I would just like him to have a bit more strength for an adult male.

KAHMINS LUXOR

Red dog with powerful head & well-placed small ears which contributed to his typical expression. Strong forechest straight front. A little long coupled & needing slightly more development of second thigh to give his rear more 'oomph'. I would like him a little shorter.

Class 1a - Baby Puppy Bitch

KAHMINS MS FANCY PANTS

Solid brindle with good fill around skull. Ears up on top. Mouth problem. Good body shape, with pleasing rear angulation.

KAHMINS MS BABY BLUES

Beautiful length of head, though needing more power to balance. Dark eye typical expression. A little longer than number one, & not quite the overall substance.

Class 5a - Intermediate Bitch

CH. KAHMINS STARDUST

Nice shape of head- well filled Dark eye, though could be marginally smaller. Slight mouth fault. Strong neck. Reasonable turn of stifle. Moved smartly.

Class 10a - Australian Bred Bitch

CH CHRYSALISS SHES SO FANCY

Pretty head with good roman finish. Small ears set well up on head. Dark eye, could be a tad smaller. Correct mouth. Straight bone in front. Cobby with correct topline. More turn in rear would improve her drive in movement. Although of excellent height, she did not have the quality of bone & substance that I would like.

Class 11a - Open Bitch

SCHARDALE MY CO BELLIGERANT

A very pleasing outline with lovely overall shape. Head of good length & profile with adequate fill. Dark, small eye & small well-set ears completed her virtuous expression. Angulation both fore & aft was pleasing. Good balance of size & substance. A little immaturity became evident on the move. Great attitude!

DEROYALE QUEEN OF HEARTS

Tricolour with good length of head but needs more fill through. Dark eye but largish ears. Mouth fault. Straight bone in front. Could be a tad shorter. Rear well turned.

DAMINABUL BREAKIN DA RULZ

Pretty shaped head with great length & balance. Ears correctly placed, dark eye but a little kind. Good quality round bone. Could be shorter. Movement not good today- pasterny in front & quite close in rear. Size of concern.
