




Tell Us More:

Dottie settled in very quickly, I had forgotten what it was like to have a puppy in the house with all that chewing. She had a thing for socks for a while and odd socks became the norm, thankfully she has grown out of that. She has walked out the bush nearly every day since she arrived and now it is essential for her to run every day, so much energy.

I had been looking around for puppy classes and was told about this club. I had not formally trained a dog before so it has been a good learning experience for both of us. Dottie started at puppy school and is now at level 3 in obedience. She completed the beginners agility course at the end of last year and is currently attending part 2. She loves the agility and it is very hard to slow her down, although, I think I confuse her. I'm sure with practice both of us will get better at it. Dottie can be very focussed and is obsessive about balls. She will chase a tennis ball for as long as you will throw it for her. She will go hunting for balls and drop them at your feet; she will follow you around from one place to another with ball wanting to play. She is also very good with a soccer ball kicking it with her two front legs at high speed. Her other obsession is water; Dot loves to swim and over summer almost taught herself to body surf in the sea. I am very grateful to the instructors who give up their time to help us train our dogs. I am able to take Dottie to lots of places and she is well behaved.
