Reminders:

*Club Phone: We now have a club mobile phone. Call 0497 242 667 for all queries.

*Signing prior to class: it is essential for safety reasons we know who is in class. Please ensure you sign in prior to starting class each session. This also helps us keep track of people's attendance and those eligible for graduation. *Mobile Phones: Please refrain from using your mobile phone in class. If you are expecting an important call, please inform your instructor and if the call occurs, remove yourself from the class prior to answering. Check with the instructor prior to re-joining the class so you are aware of what is happening within the class.

*Footwear: For safety reasons, please ensure you are wearing sturdy, closed in footwear at all times. Thongs and high heels are not appropriate and unsafe for class and you may be asked not to take part for your own safety. *Parking: Please use common sense when parking. Parking behind the clubhouse is restricted to committee members and instructors. Please keep roadways clear to ensure ease of access for all using the carpark. You will need to park on the road if the carpark is full.

***Training in the cooler weather:** Take advantage of the cooler weather and increase the amount of training and exercise you are doing with your dog. You and your dog will only progress if you work throughout the week to consolidate what you have learnt in class.

*Give Me Space: Please remember to give other members and their dogs who are wearing a yellow high-vis vest space before and after class as well as during training. Please show your respect and support for these handlers by following this as they work hard to help their dogs overcome their barriers.

*Dogs on lead at all times unless instructed to be off lead by an instructor. Off lead play before or after class needs to occur on the tennis courts or in the puppy pens. While your dog may be okay, it may be causing stress or over excitement for other dogs or be an unnecessary distraction for people who are still working with their dogs.

The Doggy Diner

Chicken Liver Biscuits

2 cups Flour3 tbs. Vegetable oil1 egg, lightly beaten1/2 cup chicken broth1 cup cooked chicken liver, chopped

1 cup wheat germ 2 tsp. parsley

Combine flour and wheat germ. In separate bowl, beat egg with oil, then add broth & parsley, mix well. Add the dry ingredients to bowl a little at a time, stirring well. Fold in chicken livers and mix well. Dough will be firm. Turn dough out on lightly floured surface and knead briefly. Roll out 1/2" thick and cut into shapes. Place on greased cookie sheet 1" apart. Bake at 400F for 15 minutes or until firm. Store in refrigerator.

Can my Dog eat that?

Many of us feed our dogs scraps or food from the table. Whilst in many instances this is fine we all need to be aware that dog stomachs are designed to digest different food to us. Some foods are dangerous and possible deadly to dogs.

Macadamia Nuts

Raw and roasted macadamia nuts can be a danger of for pets. The toxic compound is unknown, but the effect of macadamia nuts is to cause locomotory difficulties. Dogs develop a tremor of the skeletal muscles, and weakness or paralysis of the hindquarters. Affected dogs are often unable to rise and are distressed, usually panting. Some affected dogs have swollen limbs and show pain when the limbs are manipulated.

Dogs have been affected by eating as few as six macadamia kernels (nuts without the shell) while others had eaten approximately forty kernels. Some effected dogs have also been given macadamia butter.

Cooked Bones

Cooked bones - they can splinter and cause gut perforation, as well as blockages in the intestine, tooth fractures, and cooked chop bones can get stuck across the roof of the mouth.

Introductory Agility Course

Commencing Sunday 28th October 2018

Requirements to participate:

- Dog needs to have a reliable distracted recall as some work is off-lead.
- Flat soft collar ONLY to be used.
- Dogs less than 14 months of age may be restricted in some activities due to the impact on soft bones/joints. This is to prevent injury to growing puppies.

Course Outline:

The course will work on establishing the foundations of agility including basic handling skills and the safe execution of equipment.

Course Dates/Time:

The classes will be held on Sundays at 10:30am on October 28th, November 4th, November 18th and November 25th. Classes will be approx. 2 hours each session.

Enrolment Fee & Participation:

Class size is limited to 8 dogs & handlers. If you wish to participate, please complete the below enrolment form and return to Sarah Crocker or via the Club office with payment.

Course fee: \$100

All participants are required to assist in the set up and pack up of the equipment each week.
