This is the final issue for 2014.


I would like to wish everyone a very Merry Christmas and a Happy and successful New Year.

Eugene started working with dogs in 1954 as a dog bather at a French Poodle Shop in Houston, Texas. He attended his first dog Show in 1955 and then decided that he wanted to show dogs.

He became an All-Breed licensed handler in 1968 and continued to show dogs professionally for some 33 years. Upon retirement, he moved in to the world of judging.

During that time, Eugene bred Poodles, Cocker Spaniels, Italian Greyhounds, Maltese, Yorkshire Terriers, Salukis, and Afghan Hounds. As a handler he had helped many of his clients with their breeding programs, including choosing studs, and picking puppies. This helped him with his own breeding program.

Eugene started judging in 1990, with the Hound Group. He is now also licenced to judge Gundogs, Toy and Non-Sporting Groups, Best in Show and Junior Handlers.

He has judged in Australia, Canada, Finland, Indonesia, Japan, New Zealand, Sweden, Taiwan, and Thailand. Currently, he judges around 60 Shows per year.



Robert and Yvonne Lauder had some


excitement when a storm hit Sydney at the end of November and blew a large tree over, smashing fences and sheds.

It started off well when she won the award for my campus for the Caltex Best All Rounder Award, presented in recognition


of a student's excellence in academic, leadership, sporting and community service activities.

Not a good day to end the year. Get well soon Emily!



Breaking Health News

Some exciting news has come regarding Glaucoma in BGV's.

It is with great pleasure and excitement that PBGVCA and the PBGV Health and Rescue Foundation are able to share some long awaited news that will directly impact the health and well-being of our beloved PBGVs.

We have just received confirmation that progress has been made and the gene responsible for Primary Open Angle Glaucoma (POAG) has been identified by researchers at The Animal Health Trust in the U.K. Following is email confirmation received from Cathryn Mellersh PhD of the AHT. "Good afternoon everyone,

It is my great pleasure to confirm that we have identified the mutation responsible for primary open angle glaucoma in the Petit Basset Griffon Vendeen.

We identified the mutation last week, and have now carried out the validation experiments necessary to confirm its association with the disease.

We are now in a position to develop a DNA test, based on the causal mutation that will be available in early 2015. We will of course keep you updated with the precise details of the test, as they are finalised. I would like to thank everyone who has played their part in this success store, particularly the owners and ophthalmologists who have sent us DNA from the dogs that have contributed to this research. Best wishes. Cathryn







Ch. Soletrader Zee or Zed also won Winners Dog at the BGV National this year as well


Europe


The Helsinki Winners show was the biggest in Europe with over 7000 entries.


