If I find you to be a suitable home to puppy match, your puppy will be ready to go home with you at eight weeks of age. Puppy will come with his/her first vaccinations, wormed, microchipped, veterinary health certificate, a puppy pack from myself and Royal Canin 4kg Medium Puppy Dry Food which shall be organised prior to puppy leaving.
