Lynette grew up with Terriers with her first "pet" being an Australian Terrier. Thus began a life long passion for a variety of dog breeds, dog showing and eventual attainment of licensure as an All-Breed Best in Show judge with the Australian National Kennel Council (ANKC).

Since first stepping into the show ring in 1985, she has been an active member of the dog world in the State of New South Wales (NSW). Lynette has enjoyed many successes with her Westies, some highlights include:

- 'Terrier of the Year' in NSW, seven times
- Best in Show awards both All Breeds and at Specialty levels
- Best in Show at the Great Joint Terrier Show

Best in Show (3) at The Sydney Royal.

Lynette purchased her foundation Jack Russell Terrier bitch in 1993. From this foundation, she developed and established a line of Champions and Grand Champions, not only in Australia, but around the world. Her Jack Russell Terriers have enjoyed many successes, among them:

- Best in Show at the Great Joint Terrier Show
- 'Terrier of the Year' in NSW
- Best Puppy in Group at The Brisbane Royal, returning the following year to win
- Best in the Terrier Group at The Brisbane Royal

Best in Show awards both All Breeds and at Specialty levels

Successes in other breeds include Wire Fox Terriers, Sealyham Terriers, and Whippets.

Currently, Lynette is the Senior Vice President of Dogs NSW and The Terrier Coordinator for The Dogs NSW judges Training Program. Actively involved in various dog clubs, Lynette is a former President of the British Terrier Club of NSW, for 13 years after serving as Secretary for ten years. Lynette is also an active member of Dogs NSW Media and Government Legislation Committee, Spring Fair Committee and Member of The Dog NSW Judges Committee and Chair of the Finance Committee

Lynette has written breed lectures for the West Highland WhiteTerrier and the Jack Russell Terrier, which she has presented to the aspirant Terrier judges in NSW on a numerous occasions. Lynette has also presented a breed lecture on the Jack Russell Terrier to Terrier Judges and enthusiasts in Scandinavia and other FCI countries.

Most recently, a West Highland White Terrier owned and handled by Lynette made history by becoming the first Westie in Australia to attain the title of 'Supreme Champion'.

As an ANKC licensed All-Breeds judge, Lynette has enjoyed judging appointments in Sweden, Denmark, Italy, The Philippines, South Africa, New Zealand and in all states in Australia, at both Specialty and All Breeds Shows. Lynette had the great pleasure of judging Jack Russell Terriers and West Highland WhiteTerriers at the prestigious 2015 World Dog Show held in Milan, Italy.

I had travelled to numerous countries around the world due to my business interests and have always tried to visit dog shows during these trips, learning many interesting aspects of the dog fancy and meeting fanciers around the world.

Together with my late wife Fran I have been involved in the Dog World since 1969, breeding, exhibiting, and Judging as well as being involved in the organizing side of Dog Shows. I now have grandchildren and great grandchildren involved in the showring.

I have owned, bred, and exhibited successful dogs in Chihuahuas, Japanese Chins, Lhasa Apsos, Japanese Akitas. Norfolk Terriers as well as both varieties of Bull Terriers and have finished many Champions in these breeds.

However, Bull Terriers, both Standard and Miniature, became my passion. My most successful Bull Terrier was Bull Terrier of The Year five years in a row for The Auckland Bull Terrier Club.

I commenced judging in 1973 and have judged Ribbon Parades and Open Shows in All Breeds. I am Licensed to Award Challenge Certificates for All Terrier Breeds. I had the honour of judging the First Championship Show for The Northern Staffordshire Bull Terrier Club in Auckland and I have judged the Auckland Bull Terrier Club Open Show, The Canterbury Bull Terrier Open Show and The Central and Canterbury Terrier Club Championship Shows. I have Judged Terriers in most States of Australia and throughout New Zealand, the Inaugural Championship Show for The Singapore Bull Terrier Club, as well as Bull Terrier Club Specialist shows in Australia and Denmark.

I have attended Cruft's Dog Show in the UK and The Silverwood Trophy shows in the USA.

I have judged The Bull Terrier Club of Belgium in conjunction with CETS trophy show (Easter 2017) I have judge the A M B T C in October 2017

I am a Life Member and was up until my move to Australia, President of The North Shore Kennel Club (NZ) President of The Terrier Club Auckland and am a Life Member of The Asian Breeds Club (NZ) and The Terrier Club of Auckland. I have served as a mediator in disputes for the New Zealand Kennel Club, have served as Vice-Chairperson for the NZKC Auckland Exhibition Centre Grounds Committee, and Chairman for the Northern Classic Show. I have managed the illustrious Blue-Ribbon Award Show for many years and am a past member of the NZKC Executive Council. I have extensive experience in the administrative side of the dog world and enjoy being involved in the organizing of large events in the dog world.

In early 1970's I was successful in breeding and showing West Highland White Terriers. In 1982 I became involved with Norfolk Terriers importing many from the UK and the USA since that time. I have been successful in the show ring winning Best in Shows All Breeds and several gaining their Grand and Supreme Championships. In addition I have been closely involved with Norwich Terriers as well as showing and handling Dalmatians and German Shepherds.

I gained my judges licence for Terriers in 2002 following this up with my Toy licence in 2006. During this time I had the opportunity to judge not just in Australia but also New Zealand.
