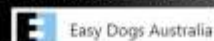

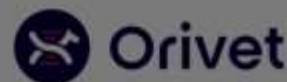

## **DOGS**

### **CLASS: BABY PUPPY (1 entered)**

#### **1<sup>st</sup> Place – POTENS WILD HUNT (#1)**

Young pup. Still developing. Strong head. Neck of good reach into fairly well-placed shoulder. Small eye with ears placed correctly. Tail set correctly. Moved good both ways.

### **CLASS: JUNIOR DOG (2 entered)**

#### **1<sup>st</sup> Place – BRAXSTAR BORN TO BE BAD (#3)**

Compact young dog, short in couplings, square. showing ample promise. Head of good length with eyes place correctly. Hindquarters moderately angulated. Tail set on and carried well. Moved well with ample reach.

### **CLASS: INTERMEDIATE DOG (2 entered)**

#### **1<sup>st</sup> Place – BRASSHEAD BUTCH CASSIDY (AI) (#4)**

18month old red and white dog. Upstanding. Head long and smooth curved profile. Neck well reaching flowing into well laid back shoulder. Has not yet reached his potential, but will fill out in time to come. Slightly long cast. Hindquarters well angulated. Very well presented by handler.

### **CLASS: AUSTRALIAN BRED (3 entered)**

#### **1<sup>st</sup> Place – BRAXSTAR I LIKE IT LOUD (AI) (#7)**

Brindle and White dog. Upstanding. Head has a moderate profile. Dark eyes and nose show good pigmentation. Correct dentition. Short in couplings. Feet neat and compact. Bone slightly light. Hindquarters lacked angulation. Moved well coming straight and true, lacked drive from hindquarters. Overall well balanced terrier type.



**2<sup>nd</sup> Place – SEMAJON BOB MARLEY (#8)**

Lovely dog with ample type, powerful well filled head. Small eyes and ears that are placed correctly resulted in a keen expression. Well boned and well knuckled up. Deep chest. Short back. Moved with purpose with ample drive. Unfortunately, his mouth fault is his cross to bear.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Place – CH SIRRAM SIAM (#6)**

Lacked quality, soundness and type. Poor presentation did not help its cause, both dog and handler were not happy in the ring.

**CLASS: OPEN (2 entered)**

**1<sup>st</sup> Place – BULROARUS THE BOSS (#10)**

*Multum in Parvo* is the first thing that comes to mind when judging this dog. He is substantial and powerful in appearance yet avoiding coarseness. Head long and powerful with good fill and great depth of muzzle. Profile gently curving. Underjaw thick and square. Eyes and ears placed correctly made for good expression. Neck thick, strong and muscular flowing into well laid shoulders. Great spring of rib and deep chest, broad over the withers. Back short and compact gave him a square outline. Tail set on correct and carried horizontal to topline. Hindquarters well angulated with well developed second thigh. Hock well let down. Moved well behind, but paddled coming. His type, substance and overall presence earned him the **BEST IN SHOW**.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Place – KAHA HIGH ROLLER (AI) (#9)**

Sound dog. Keen expression from dark eyes and well placed ears. Upright in shoulder. Short in couplings. Hindquarters lack angulation.

## **BITCHES**

**CLASS: BABY PUPPY (1 entered)**

**1<sup>st</sup> Place – POTENS BLOOD OF ELVES (#11)**

Lovely young bitch with a feminine head, long and gentle profile. Eye placed well giving down face. Good silhouette.

**CLASS: MINOR PUPPY (1 entered)**

**1<sup>st</sup> Place – SIRRAM ELLE (#12)**

Slightly long in couplings. Needed more fill. Front straight. Moved fairly well coming, close behind and lacking drive.

**CLASS: PUPPY (7 entered)**

**1<sup>st</sup> Place – LOWDINA CHATROOM ICON (#19)**

Quality bitch, filled to the brim with type and virtue. Typical head, long and strong complimented by small, dark and triangular eyes placed correctly. Small ears placed on top of her head. Typical expression. Square and thick underjaw. Good depth of muzzle. Excellent profile with a roman finish. Reaching neck strong and flowing into well laid shoulder. Excellent front, straight forelegs with catlike feet that are well knuckled-up. Good round bone. Back short and compact with a top line that held well on the move. Tail set on correctly at the croup, short thick at the root and tapering. Moved well in all directions illustrating both reach and drive. All her type and quality earned her **RUNNER-UP BEST IN SHOW.**

**2<sup>nd</sup> Place – BULLPATCHY BATTLE SCARS (#13)**

Shapely white bitch with a lovely front, straight and well boned. Dark eye well placed. Short and compact made for overall balance and soundness. Moved well coming and going, straight and true.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Place – KAHA CHOIR GIRL (#17)**

Terrier Type Bitch, lacked underjaw. Good front, straight and well boned. Well angulated hindquarters. Moved moderately well.

**CLASS: JUNIOR (4 entered)**

**1<sup>st</sup> Place – BULLROY CANDY KISS (#23)**

Shapely bitch, compact in body and well balanced. Front straight with well knuckled feet. Lacks head quality. Tail set and carried to high over the back, spoiled outline. Moved well.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Place – HELLOFABULL DIABLO DIVA (#20)**

Slightly long in back, head lacks fill. Moved okay.

**CLASS: INTERMEDIATE (1 entered)**

**1<sup>st</sup> Place – BULLPATCHY MOONLIGHTS SHADOW (#24)**

Overall well balanced, head decent with moderate profile. Eyes and ears well placed. Correct dentition. Neck long. Body compact.

**CLASS: AUSTRALIAN BRED (4 entered)**

**1<sup>st</sup> Place – BRASSHEAD PARTY GIRL (AI) (#25)**

Good head profile. Neck well reaching. Short in couplings. Moderate hind angulation.

**CLASS: AUSTRALIAN BRED (4 entered)**

**1<sup>st</sup> Place – KAHA BIG BUCKS (#30)**

Sound bitch, elegant outline. Head of decent quality could use more underjaw. Neck moderate in length, Body compact. Moved well.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Place – CHRYSALISS HAVANA TRI (#31)**

compact and square. Hindquarters well angulated. Moved okay.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Place – BULLROY FOURSHADESOFWHITE (#29)**

terrier type, lacking substance and overall balance.

**After talking to a number of fellow exhibitors it became apparent that many of us were unaware of recent changes made to rules regarding exhibiting under judges.**

**For your convenience, I have pasted the changes below.**

**They mainly pertain to proprietary interest/ownership, handling, and use of stud dogs.**

### **Dogs Australia Current Rules related to exhibitors.**

Regulations Part 5 "Conformation Show" Effective 1 July

#### SECTION 4 Exhibitors

##### 4.1 Ownership Interest

4.1.1 No person shall exhibit a dog in any sanctioned conformation exhibition at which a judge who is a member of the competitor's immediate family, or who resides at the same address, or who has had a proprietary interest in such dog whether solely or in partnership is scheduled to officiate

4.1.2 A person may not exhibit or handle under a judge officiating at a conformation show where:

- a. The person is a member of the judge's family and/or resides at the same address as the judge.
- b. The judge has or has had any ownership interest in a dog or dogs solely or in partnership with the member within a period of 12 months prior to the conformation show.
- c. Where the judge has handled any dog owned, leased or part leased by the person within a period of 12 months prior to the conformation show.
- d. The person has accommodated the judge or been accommodated by the judge within a period of 12 months prior to the conformation show or intends to accommodate the judge within 24 hours after the conformation show
- e. The judge has trained or groomed for reward, for gift or favour a dog owned, or part owned, leased or part leased by the person in a period of 12 months prior to the conformation show
- f. The dog was bred by the judge or the judge's family.
- g. For the purposes of these regulations the definition "handled" does not include any circumstance where a person has assisted another exhibitor who, due to a judging decision on the day, was required to compete with two or more exhibits at the same time. (Clause 4.1.2 amended 10/22, 7.5.3. Effective 01/01/23)

### 3. Regulations Part 5 – Conformation Shows: Amendment to Section 4.1

It was resolved that Regulations Part 5 – Section 1 – Definitions and Classes Regulation 1.1.7 that  
Currently reads:

#### 1.1.7 Definitions and Classes

Proprietary Interest – means having some legal or equitable interest in an animal on an on-going basis or the breeder of the exhibit. For the purposes of these Regulations the definition does not include using a Judge's stud dog or boarding a dog at a Judge's boarding kennel.

**Be deleted.**

AND for Section 4.1 Proprietary Interest to be amended as follows.

Section 4.1 Proprietary Ownership Interest as follows:

- 4.1.2 A person may not enter, exhibit or handle under a judge officiating at a conformation show where:
- a. The person is a member of the judge's family and/or resides at the same address as the judge.
  - b. The judge has or has had any **proprietary ownership** interest in a dog or dogs solely or in partnership with the member within a period of 12 months prior to the conformation show.
  - c. Where the judge has handled any dog owned, leased or part leased by the person within a period of 12 months prior to the conformation show.
  - d. ~~The person has handled any dog owned or part owned or leased, or part leased by the judge in a period of 12 months prior to the conformation show.~~ The person has accommodated the judge or been accommodated by the judge within a period of 12 months prior to the conformation show or intends to accommodate the judge within 24 hours after the conformation show.
  - e. The judge has trained or groomed for reward, for gift or favour a dog owned, or part owned, leased or part leased by the person in a period of 12 months prior to the conformation show.
  - f. The dog was bred by the judge or the judge's family.
  - g. ***For the purposes of these Regulations the definition "handled" does not include any circumstance where a person has assisted another exhibitor who, due to a judging decision on the day, was required to compete with two or more exhibits at the same time***
  - h. ~~Either the exhibitor or the judge has used a stud dog belonging to the other within the last 6 months.~~

This amendment will be effective from 1 January 2023.

Our next Doppler clinic will be on **Wednesday 29th November** for 5 dogs at the Werribee Clinic facility (previously UVET) which has now reopened under Green Cross. I have several spots left for this date.

If you would like to put your name down for an upcoming clinic or would like more information please contact me directly. Your test results are confidential and you are in no way obligated to divulge your results to anyone. The reports are emailed by the cardiologist directly to you.

This is an opportunity to test your breeding stock at a rate of \$300 per animal which is enabled due to having a booking of 5 animals.
