Baby Puppy Dog

1st Mrs M & Miss E Edwards' Nightquest Double O Seven (Am. Gr Ch Dal Primo In The Making/Ch Nightquest Youngstar)

A 4 mth old fawn puppy. Nice head, bite acceptable, good pigmentation and eye colour, level topline, good prosternum. Moved well with nice balance on the move. Should develop well.

2nd Mrs M & Miss E Edwards' Nightquest Seven Seas (Am. Gr Ch Dal Primo In The Making/Ch Nightquest Youngstar)

A promising fawn puppy. Nice head, bitch acceptable. Head like first puppy. Moved well.



3rd Ms J Freeman, Mr G Sparham & Miss B Turner's Gameguard Major Tom (Chalfs Starman At Oldwell/Ch Gameguard Cover Me In Sunshine(Ai))

Another fawn puppy. Pleasing head. Front not as good as the others and feet slightly splayed. Still feel he will improve as he matures.

Puppy Dog

1st Mr A & Mrs M Smith's Anmenta Velvet Krush (Ch Blaquevil Lorenzo Saint John/Ch Anmenta Black Velvet)

An 11mth old fawn puppy dog. Good breed type. Nervous on the day, good bite, nice balance on the move. Should improve with maturity.



Junior Dog

1st Miss S Johnson's Sweetbryar I Got Th Music Inme (Am. Gr Ch Dal Primo Magic Moment (Imp Usa)/Ch Sweetbryar Strictly Ballroom)

Although quite a young fawn dog I really liked this boy, although a bit boisterous. A very excellent head, a good stop, dark eye, well arched neck and level topline. Movement was powerful with a sense of purpose. A very promising dog. Dog CC, Runner Up To Best In Show, Junior In Show



Intermediate Dog

1st Mrs K & Mr C Phillips' Ch Sweetfleet Bulletproof (Ch Bullgladiata Tennessee Whisky (Ai)/Ch Sweetfleet Waltizing Matilda)

This fawn dog had good substance, a pleasing head, good bone, well let down chest. Nice balance on the move with good angulation.



2nd Miss J Pendle's Ch Bullnarli Dodge Ramm (Ch Neut. Ch Waterlea Thunda Frm Downunda (Imp NZ)/Ch Salieri Sunshine Totha Ground (Ai))

Fawn dog, nice head, good arch of neck. Moved well, not as balanced as the first dog. Angulation and chest not as good as the first dog.



Australian Bred Dog

1st Mrs M & Miss E Edwards' Ch Nightquest Star Kingdom (Sup Ch Mymooch Judges Quest/Gr Ch Nightquest Star Magic)

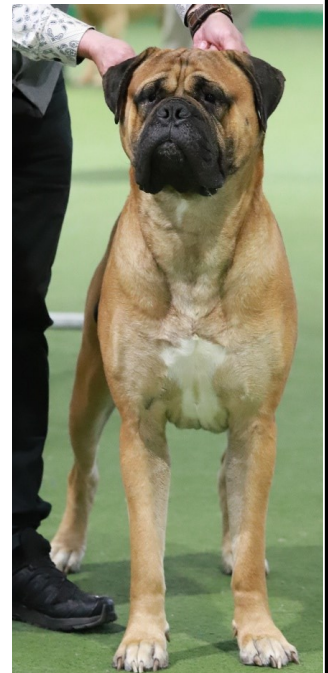
Pleasing head, acceptable bite, nicely balanced on the move with good angulation, although smaller in height he was well put together.





2nd Mr A & Mrs M Smith's Sup Ch Anmnetta Ace Kicker (Sup.Ch Anmenta Blonde Ambition/Remyk The Skyes The Limit)
A large fawn dog, good head,nice stop. A little heavy in wrinkle and high in the rear.

3rd Mr G & Mrs P Barber's Ch Banobrae Mr Darcy (Ch Banobrae Black Label(Ai)/Ch Grand. Ch Banobrae Hell Or High Water)
Good size dog. Average head, high in the rear, did not have the balanced movement as the first dog. Feet could be better.



Open Dog

1st Mrs M & Miss E Edwards C.I.B Sup Ch Mymooch Judges Quest (Nightquest Assertive Lad/Ch Mymooch Smashing Diva(Ai))
Medium size dog with good substance. Moved well. Pleasing head with dark eye. Would have like more front, overall a nice dog.
Res Dog CC



2nd Miss R Crilly & Mr K Wernicke's Ch Bullgladiata Tennessee Whiskey (Eng Ch Old Manila's Whisky Mac For Optimus (Nor)/Ch Bullgladiata Nyx (Ai))
A pleasing dog overall. Good head, a little high in rear. Good front, feet could be better.



3rd Mrs C Redding's Ch Banobrae Thunderstruck (Gameguard Eskimo Pie(Ai)/Ch Banobrae Blackberry Tart (Ai))
This dog was not happy, I could not mouth him. Seemed very nervous. Lacked arch of neck. He may be better on another day.



Baby Puppy Bitch

1st Mrs M & Miss E Edwards' Nightquest Twenty Four Seven (Am. Gr Ch Dal Primo In 7he Making/Ch Nightquest Youngstar)
Pleasing head, should develop well with good pigment.
Baby Puppy In Show

2nd Mr G Sparham & Miss B Turner's Gameguard Ziggy Stardust (Chalfs Starman At Oldwell/Ch Gameguard Cover Me In Sunshine (Ai))

A promising puppy too, not quite as good as the 1st place winner, mouth acceptable, should develop well.



3rd Mrs M & Miss E Edwards' Nightquest Seven Up (Am. Gr Ch Dal Primo In 7he Making/Ch Nightquest Youngstar)
This puppy in my opinion had too much pigment all around, still a nice pup. As with all puppies it's a wait and see.

Puppy Bitch

1st Ms J M Karena's Banobrae First Light (Bullmaster Black Tartan (Ai)/Ch Banobrae Rainshadow)

A very pleasing puppy, good head, ear set and mouth, nice movement, level topline. I would like to see more front. This may develop later.

Puppy In Show



2nd Bullmaster Kennels' Bullmaster Hot Chilli Woman (Ch Bullmaster Texas Ranger(Ai)/Bullmaster Serendipity)
This puppy not quite as good as the 1st place winner. Moved OK but a bit high in the rear. May level out later. Lacking a little in angulation on rear and plaited when moving.

Junior Bitch

1st Mr A & Mrs M Smith's Anmenta Velvet Mafia (Ch Blaquevil Lorenzo Saint John/Ch Anmenta Black Velvet)

A nice brindle bitch Good head, excellent mouth, good topline, moved well. Good rear angulation, good tail set. Overall, very good.



Intermediate Bitch

1st Miss R Crilly & Mr K Wernicke's Ch Bullgladiata Broken Halos (Ch Bullgladiata Tennesse Whisky (Ai)/Bullgladiata Elektra)

Very nice bitch, good head, excellent mouth, good topline, moved well. Good rear angulation, good tail set. Overall very good.

Best Intermediate In Show



2nd Mrs M & Miss E Edwards' Ch Nightquest Sacred Choice (C.I.B. Sup.Ch Mymooch Judges Quest/ Ch Nightquest She Will Reign)

Pleasing bitch, good pigment, acceptable mouth, good dark eye. Nice topline, good cat like feet.

Maybe a little too much rear angulation.



3rd Miss J Pendle & Miss C Berlyn's C.I.B.-J Ch Bullnarli Ultimate Pick Up (Ch Neut. Ch Waterlea Thunda Frm Downunda (Imp Nzl)/Ch Salieri Sunshine Totha Ground (Ai))

This bitch had a good black mask, well let down in front. A little cumbersome on the move, a little on the heavy side.



Australian Bred Bitch

1st Ms J Freeman, Mr G Sparham & Miss B Turner's Ch Gameguard Cover Me In Sunshine (Am. Ch Am. Gr Ch Marconiann'ridgetops Thunder Road/ A2o Ch C.I.B. Ch Sup.Ch Gameguard Innuendo)

Nice fawn bitch, excellent mouth, pigment OK. Good spring of rib. Moved well, overall balanced. Very good all around.

Best Australian Bred in Show



2nd Mr G & Mrs P Barber's Ch Banobrae Kitty Bennett (Ch Banobrae Black Label(Ai)/Ch Grand. Ch Banobrae Hell Or High Water)
 A good brindled bitch. Nice square head, excellent prosternum. Seemed a little nervous on the day, not as good as my 1st place winner.



3rd Bullmaster Knls' Gr Ch Bullmaster Scandalous Affair (Eng Ch, Int Ch, Sup Ch Costog Mompessons Home Bru/ Ch Bullmaster Lexington Avenue)
 A fawn bitch, nice front, pigment fading with age. Moved OK. Nice ear set, acceptable mouth. A little on the heavy side.



Open Bitch
 1st Mr G Sparham & Miss B Turner's Sup Ch Gameguard Innuendo (C.I.B. Ch Gameguard Power Of One(Ai)/Ch NZ. Ch Brookpark Yukon Reflection (Imp NZ)
 This is an excellent bitch. Good head, acceptable mouth, good angulation, balanced mover. Well let down in front & strong prosternum, especially due to her age. A very worthy Best In Show winner.



2nd Mrs M & Miss E Edwards' Ch Nightquest Youngstar (Gr Ch Nightquest Head Turner/Gr Ch Nightquest Star Magic)
 Another nice bitch, good pigment, acceptable mouth. Well down in front. Little out of coat. Moved well.



3rd Mrs K & Mr C Phillips' Sweetfleet Shes Got The Look (Ch Bullgladiata Tennessee Whisky (Ai)/Ch Sweetfleet Waltizing Matilda)
 This fawn bitch had an excellent mouth, good dark eye. Moved reasonable, little high in the rear.



Neuter Bitch
 1st Bullmaster Kennels' Ch Bullmaster Twist Of Fate (Ch Bullmaster Us Marshall (Ai)/Ch Bullmaster Madison Avenue)
 This bitch is a little short in muzzle, lacked stop, acceptable mouth, short in loin, good front, moved OK
