

Beware, real Blueys are 'little land sharks'

The success of ABC cartoon Bluey has driven a resurgence of interest in blue heelers, but breeders are urging families to think twice before buying the dogs.

Demand for blue heelers and red heelers outstripped supply before the show, about a family of Australian cattle dogs in Queensland, became the most downloaded program in ABC history.

Deb Thome, the secretary of the Australian Cattle Dog Club of Victoria, said she was contacted by numerous families interested in the breed as a result of the show. She said the dogs were not for everyone, and only suited families willing to put in the time and effort to train and exercise them.

"The show does put our dogs out there and that's a wonderful thing, but we also have to be realistic when we place our puppies because we don't want them to end up in a pound," Ms Thorne said. "Our job is to inform people of the realities of having an eightweek-old cattle dog puppy, who has very sharp teeth and a highpitched bark. They are cute and beautiful, but they are little land sharks. They need to be trained, and that takes time and effort."

Bluey is by far the most downloaded show in ABC history and has been watched more than 150 million times.

It has also been screened in Britain, the US and China after being picked up by the BBC and Disney, and has been nominated for next year's International Emmy Kids Awards.

Jean Purcell, who breeds cattle

dogs at Pearcedale, southeast of Melbourne, said she feared cattle dogs bought for the wrong reasons could end up abandoned.

"It's like the kelpies with (hit 2011 movie) Red Dog they became popular and a lot of them ended up in rescues and pounds because they couldn't handle because they couldn't handle being in suburbia," she said.

"Our dogs will handle being in suburbia, providing it's an active family that is prepared to take the dog on runs and walks."

Both Ms Purcell and Ms Thome said they carefully checked potential buyers to ensure they were suitable owners before they sold puppies. "I do screen the families that come to buy cattle dogs," she said.

"They are incredible pets but they must go to the right place."

Cattle dogs have had a reputation for aggression and have often been used as guard dogs, but Ms Purcell said selective breeding had significantly improved the temperament of the breed.

Ms Thorne said about 900 dogs were bred each year, down from about 3000 a decade ago.
