# Letter from our Secretary

Hello to all of our Members, Life Members and Patron.

What an unusual start to the year so far, we hope that everyone is safe and healthy.

As most would know, due to Covid19, DVic has closed all grounds and No events of any kind are being held.

The committee voted to Postpone our Annual Show, not Cancel it, this allows us to put it together later in the year if at all possible.

Putting a show together, starts straight after our AGM in July each year, so around 9 months in advance, and sometimes even longer.

I wish I could give you all a clearer picture, but this is untrodden ground for all of us, and we are doing the best we can, so please bare with us.

Please note, there is a new membership form in this edition, also a nomination form for committee and an Agenda form, if there is anything to put forward.

  - Best Exhibit in Show – Ch Binshaw Blue Banjo – P & C Morison (see main photo)
  - Runner Up Best in Show – Ch Tallawong Tallan Brae – Mrs & Mrs Dickson
- ACD Club had a float in the Moomba Parade for a few years.
- ACD Club held a Christmas get together each year for their Members and families with fun events for all, dogs included with their Christmas Comp. Then everyone thoroughly enjoyed a BBQ lunch.
- The club organised Dutch Auction nights, nights at the Trots and other great nights out.
- Had committee meetings at members houses, where one member went to labour but waited until the meeting was over before going to the hospital.
- The longest member is Wilma McMillan who organised the Club Raffles and still does still this day.
- In 2004 the Club had their first International Judge from Netherlands, Mrs Loes Mouchart, she bred and showed Shetland Sheepdogs. From World Dog Show Judges Biography, she stated: *“As a judge I have visited many countries but my judging in Australia of the Shetland Sheepdogs, and especially the Cattle Dogs and the Kelpies in their country of origin was definitely one of the highlights of my judging career”*.

- Summer Shows started 4 years ago and in November 2019 the shows became the The First Australian Working Dog Spectacular ... Kelpies, Australian Stumpy Tails and of course ACDs.

Application for a postal vote must be made in writing and be lodged with the Secretary 14 (fourteen) days prior to the Annual General Meeting. Within 7 (seven) days, the Secretary, in the presence of the President and one other Committee member appointed by the committee will forward an initialled Ballot Paper to each applicant and record their names. Members to whom Ballot papers are posted will under **NO** circumstances be given a second ballot paper. Completed Ballot papers are to be returned to the Secretary in envelopes endorsed **“BALLOT PAPERS”**, these envelopes will be handed (unopened) to the Scrutineers officiating at the poll.
