CRITIQUES

PUPPY DOG

1st – PUREHEEL STORM RANGER (Exhibit No. 1)

8 month old blue speckled dog of very good breed type. Well balanced with the correct height to length ratio. Good bone and substance for his age. Correct head proportions, well balanced with dark brown eyes. Well angulated front and rear, level top line and good ribbing. He moved true coming and going with a supple and tireless gait around the ring. Good temperament. Good coat.

OPPOSITE PUPPY IN SHOW

JUNIOR DOG

1st – PUREHEEL JACK FROST (Exhibit No. 2)

16 month old blue mottled dog of very good breed type. Good bone and substance. Good depth of chest. Slightly long in body. Well balanced head, dark brown eye. Correct ear set. Good spring of rib. Level topline. Correct slope of croup. Moved well coming and going and on side gait. Good temperament and in good coat.

OPPOSITE JUNIOR IN SHOW

INTERMEDIATE DOG

1st – CH BLUVERADO ROYAL RAMPAGE (Exhibit No. 3)

2 year old blue speckled dog with good bone and substance. Very good breed type. Good expression. Compactly built with correct height to length ratio. Good depth of chest. Very Good head properties. Correct slight but definite stop. Would prefer a darker eye. Good spring of rib, level topline. Well angulated front and rear. Moved true coming and going and on side gait covering the ground well. Good coat.

RESERVE CHALLENGE DOG AND BEST INTERMEDIATE IN SHOW

2nd – CLOVERDOWNS BEYOND THE LYRIC (Exhibit No. 5)

21 month old blue speckled dog of very good breed type with good bone and substance. He was compactly built. Good Head properties. Would prefer a darker eye. Level topline. Good spring of rib. Moved true coming and going. Good Coat.

3rd – SPRINGDOWNS ELVIS TO MAXS (Exhibit No. 7)

2 year old blue speckled dog of good breed type with adequate bone and substance. Compact with correct height to length ratio. Good Head properties. Would prefer more strength of muzzle and a darker eye. Good top line. Moved well coming and going. In good coat.

AUSTRALIAN BRED DOG

1st – CH WAYCREST ROYAL ALLIANCE (Exhibit No.9)

3 year old red speckled dog of very good breed type. Good depth of chest, well boned with good substance. Compact with correct height to length ratio. Head properties were good. Good eye colour. Would prefer more rear angulation. Moved well coming and going. Good coat.

OPPOSITE AUSTRALIAN BRED IN SHOW

2nd – CH WAZWALLABY BRUMBY JACK (Exhibit No.8)

4 year old red speckled dog of good breed type. Good temperament. Well balanced with correct height to length ratio. Well boned and good substance. Strong well balanced head. Would prefer more rear angulation. Moved well coming and going. Good coat.

BRED BY EXHIBIT

1st – CLOVERDOWNS FIGHT OF HIS LIFE (Exhibit No.10)

21 month old blue speckled dog with good bone and substance. Good temperament. Well balanced compact body with correct height to length ratio. Good depth of chest, good front and good feet. Strong well-balanced head with good width and depth. Correct slight but definite stop. Would prefer more rear angulation. Moved true coming and going and on side gait. Level topline. Good coat.

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN SHOW

OPEN DOG

1st – CH CLOVERDOWNS AIM HIGH AT LANDMASTER (Exhibit No.13)

3 year old blue speckled dog of very good breed type. Good expression. Strong with good bone and substance. Compact with correct height to length ratio. Good depth of chest. Good spring of rib. Good feet. Very good head properties. Correct slight but definite stop. Correct dark brown oval eye expressing a suspicious glint. Correct ear set and ears of moderate size. Well angulated front and rear. Level topline. Moved true coming and going and on side gait with a supple tireless gait. Good coat.

CHALLENGE DOG AND OPPOSITE OPEN IN SHOW

2nd – CH MELCATHRA ACE HIGH (Exhibit No.11)

2 year old blue speckled dog of very good breed type. Strong with good bone and substance. Well balanced with good depth of chest and well sprung ribs. Strong well balanced head piece. Good eye colour expressing a suspicious glint. Small ears correctly set. Well angulated in front and rear. Moved true coming and going and on side gait. Good topline. Good coat.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH

1st – PUREHEEL HAILSTORM (Exhibit No.15)

8 month old blue speckled bitch of very good breed type with good bone and substance for her age. Compactly built. Good head properties. Good eye colour. Well angulated front and rear. Moved true coming and going and on side gait covering the ground well. Level topline. Good coat.

BEST MINOR PUPPY IN SHOW

2nd – KEEGANBLUES KISS ME KATE (Exhibit No.14)

6 month old blue speckled bitch of very good breed type with good bone. She was well balanced. Good front. Good head properties. Good eye colour. Would prefer more rear angulation. Good topline. Moved true coming and going. Good Coat.

PUPPY BITCH

1st – WHYANDOO FOUR LEAF CLOVA AT ACCEBERA (Exhibit No.16)

8 month old blue speckled puppy bitch of very good breed type. Good expression. Good temperament. Well proportioned with the correct height to length ratio. Good bone and substance and length of leg. Good head piece, well balanced with correct slight but definite stop. Would prefer a slightly larger eye. Correct dark brown eye colour. Good ear placement. Well angulated front and rear with a well turned stifle. Level topline and good ribbing. Moved true coming and going and on side gait with a supple tireless gait. Good coat.

PUPPY IN SHOW

2nd – CLOVERDOWNS MASQUERADE (Exhibit No.18)

10 month old blue speckled puppy bitch of very good breed type. Good expression. Good outline, compact, slightly wide in front. Well balanced head. Correct dark brown eye. Correctly set ears of moderate size. Good angulation front and rear. Ribs well sprung. Level topline. Correct slope of croup. Sound mover. In good coat.

3rd – CLOVERDOWNS RED ALERT (Exhibit No.19)

10 month old red speckled puppy bitch of good breed type. Good outline. Well balanced. Good spring of rib. Good head properties. Correct ear set. Good eye colour. Prefer more rear angulation. Sound mover. Good coat.

JUNIOR BITCH

1st EMBROOKE SHE WILL REIGN (Exhibit No.21)

16 month old blue speckled bitch of very good breed type. Good temperament. Good expression. Compact, well balanced with the correct height to length ratio. Good depth of chest, well sprung ribs. Good bone and substance. Very good head properties. Correct dark brown eye colour and showed a suspicious glint. Small ears set correctly. Well angulated front and rear with a well turned stifle. Level topline. Moved true coming and going and on side gait with a supple and tireless gait. Good coat.

RUNNER UP BEST EXHIBIT IN SHOW AND BEST JUNIOR IN SHOW

2nd – PUREHEEL TICKET TO RIDE (Exhibit No.23)

10 month old blue speckled bitch of very good breed type. Good expression. Well balanced. Good bone and substance and good length of leg. Good spring of rib and good depth of chest. Very good head piece, typical, well balanced with a correct dark brown eye. Correct ear set and ears of moderate to small size. Well angulated. Good top line. Moved true, free, and supple coming and going and on side gait. Good Coat.

3rd – MAEHONEHE SPIRIT OF THE DOVE (Exhibit No.20)

17 month old red speckled bitch of very good breed type with good bone and substance. Well balanced. Good spring of rib and good depth of chest. Good head properties. Correct eye shape and colour. Well angulated. Good topline. Moved soundly coming and going and on side gait. In good coat.

INTERMEDIATE BITCH

1st – CH MELCATHRA MORE JOYOUS (Exhibit No.24)

2 year 11 month old blue bitch of very good breed type. Strong, compact and symmetrically built. Good bone and substance. Good head properties, well balanced with a correct slight but definite stop. Eyes dark brown and had a suspicious glint. Good ear set. Well angulated in front and rear with a well turned stifle. Level topline and good ribbing. Very sound on the move coming and going and on side gait. In good coat. **OPPOSITE INTERMEDIATE IN SHOW**

AUSTRALIAN BRED BITCH

1st – CH ACCEBERA SUGAR N SPICE AT WYHANDOO (Exhibit No.26)

3 year old red speckled bitch of good breed type. Good temperament. Prefer shorter in length. Strong with good bone and substance. Good head properties, well balanced with a correct slight but definite stop. Correct eye shape and colour. Good ear placement. Moderate angulation with slight rise over the rump. Would prefer a stronger topline. Sound on the move. Good coat.

AUSTRALIAN BRED IN SHOW – OPEN BITCH

1st GD CH BUSHEELA AKINDA MAGIC (Exhibit No.29)

5 year old red speckled bitch of very good breed type exhibiting excellent proportions. Strong, compact and symmetrically built. Good bone and substance. Good depth of chest. Level topline, good spring of rib and strongly coupled. Good expression. Very good head properties with a correct slight but definite stop. Correct dark eye colour. Correct ear size and set. Well angulated in front and rear with a well turned stifle. Well muscled. Correct tail set and slope of croup. Her movement was very true, free, tireless and supple coming and going and on side gait. Good coat.

BEST EXHIBIT IN SHOW AND BEST OPEN IN SHOW

2nd – COVERDOWNS HELLO BOYS AT LANDMASTER (Exhibit No.30)

3 year old blue bitch of very good breed type. Well balanced, compact and symmetrically built. Good bone and substance. Good depth of chest. Good spring of rib. Good expression. Good head properties, well balanced with a correct slight but definite stop. Good eye colour. Correct ear size and set. Good angulation in front and rear. Level topline. Moved soundly coming and going and on side gait. Good coat.

NEUTER DOG

1st NEUTER CH. CH BEAUVEST JACK DANIELS HT (Exhibit No.33)

7 year old blue dog of very good breed type with good bone and substance. Well balanced. Good depth of chest. Good head properties. Good eye shape and colour. Well angulated in front and rear. Level topline. Good croup. Moved soundly coming and going and on side gait. In good coat.

BEST NEUTER IN SHOW

2nd – ERUDITE MIGHTY MOUSE (Exhibit No.32)

4 year old blue dog of good breed type. Well balanced. Prefer more substance and bone. Good head properties. Good reach of neck. Good eye colour. Well angulated. Good topline. Moved well coming and going and on side gait. In good coat.

3rd – CH. CLOVERDOWNS STEAKHOUSE (Exhibit No.31)

3 year old blue speckled dog of good breed type. Well balanced. Good bone and substance. Good depth of chest. Good head properties. Good eye colour. Carrying too much condition and did not move well on the day. Needs more rear angulation. In good coat.

NEUTER BITCH

1st – AUST/NEUT CH. JINDAWAN RAPT IN DREAMTIME (Exhibit No.34)

9 year old red speckled bitch of very good breed type. Well balanced. Good bone. Good depth of chest. Good head properties. Good eye colour. Correct ear size and set. Well angulated in front and rear. Level topline. Moved well coming and going and on side gait. Good coat.

RUNNER UP NEUTER IN SHOW
