

History of the National Cocker Spaniel Council of Australia and the National Show

Several Cocker Clubs from around the country established the National Cocker Spaniel Council of Australia (NCSC(A)) in the early 1980's.

The objectives of the NCSC(A) include:

- to encourage and promote in every way the quality of breeding, care, training and exhibition of the Cocker Spaniel;
- to educate and encourage exhibitors, breeders and judges to abide by the Standard for the Cocker Spaniel, as approved by the Australian National Kennel Council.

Garry Douglas is the current President of the NCSC(A) and Linda Kantek is the current Secretary.

The first Cocker Spaniel National was hosted by the Cocker Spaniel Club of Victoria Inc. in 1985. Since then, 5 clubs have hosted the Show at intervals of around 2 years¹. Each event is eagerly anticipated and is the result of much work from a dedicated team.

The judge for each National is selected (by the State hosting the Show) from the United Kingdom's Judges "A 1" Cocker Specialist List.



Collection of exhibit numbers and catalogues

Catalogues, numbers and welcome bags may be picked up at the Secretary's Office that will be located in the Boxhall Pavilion (see above map).

Set up around the judging ring

Trolleys and grooming tables will not be allowed ringside. Spectator tables will be set up around the ring and there will be an exclusion zone around the ring.

Judging

Conformation judging will take place in the Boxhall Pavillion.

The opening ceremony on day 1 will commence at 9.30am. Judging will commence at the conclusion of the opening ceremony. On day 2 judging will commence at 9.30am.

Bitches will be judged on day 1.

Dogs and General Specials will be judged on day 2.

The order of judging will be any other colour (AOC) baby puppy, followed by solid baby puppy, then AOC minor puppy, followed by solid minor puppy and so on. A detailed program will be provided

Use of the grounds

Trailer and Vehicle Parking

No trailers or vehicles are permitted on lawn areas throughout KCC Park. This is to protect the lawn and also the below-surface irrigation that has been installed. Parking is available on all gravel and carpark marked areas of the grounds (refer to above map).

Dog Exercise Area

The Park has fenced off-lead areas. There are also barbecues and picnic tables that DOGS Victoria and Companion Dog Club members may use any time the park is open.

Please remember that unless you are in designated, fenced off-leash areas* or are participating in training or competition, your dog must be kept on a lead at all times at KCC Park.

Larger Fenced Area*

The larger fenced area to the south of the Park has for many years been used for lure coursing, followed by herding when that discipline commenced. Clubs representing these activities provided substantial funding, plus manpower, to fence the area, making it more suitable for their sports.

Please note the following:

- 1. If the ground is obviously being set up or used for either lure coursing or herding, the entire area is out of bounds for all other usage.
- If a member is already using the area at any other times, please wait until they leave before entering with your own dogs.
- Please read the conditions of use displayed near the entrances.
- 4. Please pick up after your dogs, using bags and bins provided.
- 5. Please be considerate and give others a turn if they are waiting. We suggest 15 minutes is enough, you may be able to come back later after taking a pleasant lead walk around the rest of the Park and resume your free running.

A Code of Ethics is only as good as those who abide by it so as a member of the Cocker Spaniel Club of Victoria Inc. I hereby agree that:

- I will abide by my Club's constitution and By-laws, and support the ANKC Standard for the Cocker Spaniel.
- I will comply with all Dogs Victoria Rules and Regulations where they apply.
- I will at all times whether at home, travelling, at shows, in Social Media, electronic communications or in public places, display good sportsmanship and conduct myself in such a manner to reflect credit upon my Club and the Cocker Spaniel.
- I will help to educate the public in the ANKC standard of the Breed and in all other areas where I am qualified.

- I will not knowingly sell any dog or bitch, which has defects of a nature that is detrimental to the Breed.
- I will supply each purchaser with a Certificate of Registration and Pedigree, Immunisation Certificate, Microchip Certificate and a Diet and Care Information Sheet.
- I will not sell stock without true representation to the purchaser. All advertising will be honest and not in any way misrepresentative, misleading, or fraudulent.
- I will continue to offer helpful assistance to the buyer for as long as such aid is required.
- I will not sell or donate any Cocker Spaniel to commercial dog wholesalers, retail pet dealers, or directly or indirectly allow them to be given as prizes in contest of any kind.
