## BUSINESS ARISING:

BADGE CONCEPT The Secretary present a National logo and badge concept prepared by Miss Margaret Joyce. This concept was accepted unanimously and it was resolved to extend a vote of thanks to Margaret for the excellent presentation. The design approved is for a round badge with a different background colour for each State and the Cocker body outline and printing depicted in gold. A year insert at the bottom of the badge can be altered for each Show and the round shape gives the badge a multi-function purpose for spoons, key fobs etc. from the one tooling.

K. Bennett moved the Secretary arrange with Margaret Joyce to obtain the necessary tooling and the cost for this tooling be borne by the N.C.S.C.(A). Tooling to remain in the possession of the Secretary and be loaned to member clubs when required. The motion was seconded by G. Love and carried.
