Preliminary work is well underway and fundraising has commenced (and you are all very welcome to buy tickets in our current raffle of a dog trolley!).

It is planned to hold the show on 28 and 29 September 2002. This date has been chosen because:

- ➤ It is a weekend when there are no other shows in Canberra or the local area and, subject to ACTCA approval, we will have access to the Club House and entire top area of the dog rings which will allow room to set up a marquee;
- ➤ The following weekend is the October long weekend when the Combined Canberra Canine Carnival is held this is 4 days of all breeds, group and specialty shows;
- During that week there is usually a mid-week Championship Show at Young, just a couple of hours down the road; and
- > It is during Canberra's Spring Floriade Festival.

This means that National exhibitors can choose to stay in Canberra for an extra week and participate in all these additional activities.
