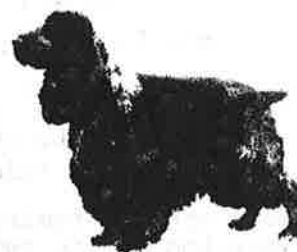

Not being a backward type of person, I just had to make myself known - and thus followed an hour of 'cocker talk' - it could have been much longer had my time permitted.

The ladies present were Sally Leeding Editor of the Newsletter - Liz Portlock who does the printing and Mrs. Bailey. Sally and I have kept in touch, trading cocker news across the miles - isn't it wonderful the friendships you make through our lovely merry cockers. Sally is now sporting a car sticker of The Cocker Spaniel Club of New South Wales - and I have just added a West of England Cocker Spaniel Club sticker to my own car. They have both caused some comment!

Members will remember with pleasure, Mrs. Kay Holmes who judged our August 1987 Show. Kay has been appointed President of the West of England Cocker Club. Kay will be judging bitches at the Club's October Championship Show and I read with interest, she has an appointment to Judge in MOSCOW. She certainly has had experience in very many countries.

At the Club's Open Show in January - judged by Mrs. Loretta Nobes - Best of Breed was Jackie Rowland's PERRYTREE THE DREAMER, reserve Best of Breed, Perry's Gemland Blue Angel and Best Puppy, Mounter's Salandals Sirocco. The Club hold another Open Show in June and their Championship Show in October.

Sally tells me she has bought a steel blue bitch from Elizabeth Maclean of Lynwater in Scotland who will be going to her first show in July. This was of great interest to me, as I visited Lynwater during a visit to Scotland and was greatly impressed all of the dogs I saw there. Great substance and wonderful temperament.

Remember our story of 'Sugar Pie' the cocker who just had to have babies of some sort to mother - well that was reprinted in West of England Newsletter and now I think many members will relate to the following story which I have taken from their current Newsletter.

Lots of good advice, but what a hard time we newcomers get. Then came the dya, the dog was bathed, the car loaded and off we went. To our delight the judge agreed with us that perhaps our dog did have some good points - we had done it, we had qualified for Crufts. We are very pleased so amny congratulated us and were grateful to those many people and friends who kept us from giving up.

The alarm went off - 4 a.m. - ready to go at 5 a.m. Our excitement of going to Crufts must have been transmitted to the dog - because he was sick!! I wore my number with great pride as Ted and I walked into Earles Court. I don't think the dog knew what all the fuss was about but true to cocker character he loved every minut. I don't think I can actually describe my nerves before we went into the ring with so many nice dogs who I knew were worthy of the first prize, as I hoped we were. Why is it Carbo will stand for ages, but just as the judge comes, he decides he's had enough and sits down! The judge asked us to move again which Carbo preferred to standing still - he didn't seem to mind my nerves and stepped out wagging his tail. Back in place - and then the Judge heading my way again - she pulled us out - us the newcomers.

Then - several minutes of examining the five dogs she had chosen from the class and we were eventually placed fourth. I couldn't believe it - WE HAD A CARD FROM CRUFTS - and I didn't care what number it had on it. Ted and I have many people to thank but most of all we thank Carbo who gives us all his love no matter what we do or say to him. (Ted & Angie Jones)

A LITTLE GIRL TO WATCH OUT FOR

All our members will know Linda Kantek - our ex-Secretary for nine years, and with husband John, proud parent of Nicole, and of course, Mark. But it is of NICOLE WE WRITE.

NICOLE, at just 8 years of age, is one of N.S.W. top gymnast. She first started gymnastics at Liverpool RSL gym club in 1988 and in her first area competition was placed 1st overall in Level 1 and in October of the same year, 1st overall in Level 2 - and then Liverpool RSL Junior Club Champion - again in the same year.

In January 1989 she was picked to join the ELITE GYMNAST PROGRAM at the Homebush State Sports Centre. In April 1989 she was placed 1st overall in Stage 3 of the Elite sub-junior program and three weeks later at the State Championships for the sub-junior program competing with the top gymnasts from NSW and ACT, she was once again placed 1st overall.

In April 1990 Nicole at the State Titles for the Elite sub-Junior Scheme, Stage 3, she was placed first overall in an OPEN AGE competition, being placed 1st on Beam, 2nd on floor and 2nd on the bars.

In APRIL 1990 Nicole also attended a selection at the Institute of Sport, Canberra, for the 1996 OLYMPIC GYMNASTIC SQUAD. She qualified for the FIRST SELECTION.

Nicole and her parents' dedication to her goal for the 1996 Olympics deserves recognition. Nicole has had to change her school to be near the State Sport Centre at Homebush. Her day starts at 5.00 a.m. when she is taken by her parents each day to the Sports Centre, and then on to school, ending her day at 7.00 p.m. This timetable is adhered to six days a week - and Nicole puts in 30 hours of training each week. She is a little girl we can all be proud to know.

(Remember this small child, with such dedication and ambition is not yet 9 years old. And to all those who think her school work must suffer - well, I managed to get Linda to tell me, she nearly always tops her class.
