General Business

 An email from the Cocker Spaniel Club of the ACT was brought up as a discussion highlighting ANKC Regulation Part 13.5.51 which states "National Breed Councils to liaise with their Affiliated Club to make sure their Championship Shows are not held within five (5) days either side of another Affiliated Club Championship Show. This is to ensure exhibitors are not precluded from participating at both shows." The majority in attendance believed it was each club's decision when their show would be conducted. However, all agreed we should work together to maximise entries and install communications that would allow coordinated decision making some suggestions were;

- a. Install a Nation schedule of events e.g. Royals, Specialties, Open Shows, Training, Events etc.
- b. Liaise with the RAS to seek scheduled breed dates to allow participation
- c. Install all information and dates on any future NCSCA website
- d. Provide Schedules / marketing information etc. ongoing to Member Clubs
 - i. Action: Secretary to provide link to ANKC Regulations and seek feedback from Clubs
