The Discussion Paper proposed the establishment of a group or process to act as a platform for ideas and information sharing about health issues across our member clubs and internationally.

In conclusion there was support for the concept, but needed further clarification on boundaries, role and functions.

POSITION PAPER IN SUPPORT OF A HEALTH EDUCATION COMMITTEE AND INFORMATIONAL HUB TO ENHANCE THE RESOURCES OF THE NCSC (AUST)

Submitted by Gillian Robinson and Meg Hardy.

1. ESTABLISHMENT OF A HEALTH EDUCATION COMMITTEE AND INFORMATIONAL HUB Reasons:

The Cocker Spaniel Club of Victoria Inc. proposes the establishment of a Health Education Committee and Informational Hub as part of the National Cocker Spaniel Council (AUST), with the aim to maintain and improve the health and well-being of the Cocker Spaniel breed.

As we argued previously in our discussion paper, the most important Cocker Spaniel Clubs in the world, the parent club, the Cocker Spaniel Club of the United Kingdom, and the English Cocker Spaniel Club of America, have information on the general health and well-being of the Cocker Spaniel on their websites which aim to provide information on, to assist in eradicating, and investigating conditions germane to our breed.

We see no reason why the National Cocker Spaniel Council of Australia should not also do the same. Such a Committee will serve to monitor the general health of the breed and provide specific information about health and welfare conditions to which Cocker Spaniels have a hereditary disposition, as well as providing details about testing procedures which have been verified by clinical research. For example, information can be supplied about a number of genetic conditions we now monitor through DNA testing, which afflict the breed and require ongoing monitoring. Moreover, disseminating research identifying protracted problems in the breed is a positive step forward in the prevention and control of genetic and/or hereditary problems, which will assist all fanciers of the breed. Such research is always ongoing as new issues come to light and existing procedures are updated.

The Information Hub will also serve as an educational tool for people who wish to understand more broadly the type of research being undertaken to help us assiduously care for our breed, and other related issues germane to the health of our dogs throughout their lives.

Proposals:

- 1. To establish a Health Committee to review current articles and research as they become available from time to time, with a view to including such articles and research in the HEALTH AND INFORMATIONAL HUB. Such articles would, for example, include peer-reviewed clinical research and published papers in academic and scientific journals.
- 2. Such articles may concern the general well-being of all breeds as well as the Cocker Spaniel. Moreover, such articles should not be limited to matters only relating to issues of hereditary conditions. We foresee a range of issues covering food, medication, lifestyle, exercise and so on.
- 3. The focus for inclusion in the Hub should be extensive and expansive, thus providing a large scope. Note, for example, the Cocker News published by the Cocker Spaniel Club of Victoria Inc, has just published an article on the negative effects of the drug Librela and will follow this with information on the negative consequences of using Apoquel.
- 4. That the NCSC (Aust) formalize information sharing with the Cocker Club (UK) and the English Cocker Club of America to share and exchange evidential information concerning new research interests and outcomes.

2. GUIDELINES FOR THE HEALTH EDUCATION COMMITTEE

The general purpose of the Health Education Committee shall be to gather and disseminate information pertinent to the physical and general well-being of the Cocker Spaniel breed to members of the NCSC (AUST), affiliated State Clubs and other international Cocker Spaniel Clubs, and to the wider dog community where appropriate.

We propose the following guidelines to assist the Committee:

- 1. To make available on the Information Hub, as specified above, such new research, scientific developments and general issues germane to the health and welfare of our breed that is easily accessible to our affiliated Clubs and the general public.
- 2. To collect, maintain and analyse information from peer-reviewed articles, scientific studies and other relevant sources which, from time to time, become available, concerning the health and welfare of the breed.
- 3. To respond to inquiries and develop educational materials, including articles, based on (2) above, to assist Cocker Spaniel fanciers, breeders, exhibitors, and the general public as necessary.
- 4. To conduct surveys of Cocker Spaniel breeders, and others, from time to time and as appropriate, to appraise the physical and general health problems of the breed.

We propose in the first instance that the Health Education Committee be established as a group of three members of the NCSC (AUST) who will first, evaluate and review all material submitted for inclusion in the Information Hub; second, submit such approved articles to all members of the NCSC (AUST) for ratification; three, with NCSC (AUST) members agreement place such material on the Information Hub and disseminate to State Clubs, international Cocker Clubs and other interested bodies as appropriate.

Procedure C2: Scheduling states that the Cocker Spaniel National Championship Show shall occur every two
years, rotating between NCSC (Aust) member clubs in an agreed order.

Issue

- The Cocker Spaniel Club of South Australia Inc re-joined NCSC (Aust) in 2024.
- The current National Championship Show rotation list does not include South Australia.
- The Cocker Spaniel Club of South Australia Inc has indicated that they will not be offering to host a National Championship Show in the near future.
- The current list will not be suitable.
