

National Cocker Spaniel Council (Australia) Website Reference Group Terms of Reference (final)

Overview

The National Cocker Spaniel Council (NCSC) website was launched on 1 September 2022. It is important that websites continue over time to evolve and present new and contemporary information. It is proposed that a Website Reference Group be established to act as a 'clearing house' for new ideas and information.

Purpose

Membership

- One representative from each of the NCSC (Australia) member clubs ie Queensland, New South Wales, ACT and Victoria.
- National Secretary and National President (if not already represented)
- Other content experts as required
- Website Administrator as Group Coordinator

Role

Reference group members will:

- Propose new content for the website. This may involve liaising with members in their club for new ideas and bringing this information forward for consideration.
- Assess proposed new ideas and content and determine suitability. This may involve reading and reviewing content in a timely manner, providing written and verbal feedback as required, examining other websites.
- 3. Make decisions and decide on new content to be added to the website.

Responsibilities

- Members will work with the website administrator and other members of the Reference Group in a constructive and positive manner.
- Provide feedback
- Consider other points of view.
- Accept the decisions of the group.
- Liaise with member clubs as required.

Time required

It is not envisaged that membership tasks would be onerous.

There may be an initial start-up zoom meeting when membership is confirmed. After that the majority of tasks would be done by email unless the group felt that a zoom meeting discussion on specific matters was required.

Appointment process

National Secretary to call for nominations from member clubs.

Length of appointment

Members to be appointed for a period of two years.
