

TREASURER'S REPORT

AGM 2023

Financial Year ended 30th September 2023

I present the Audited Accounts and Balance Sheet for the Financial Year ended 30th September 2023 to the Members.

Show revenue is down on last year, partly because we had no Open Show due to space/scheduling difficulties. Entries at the Champ. Show were down a little on last year but this seems to be the trend at the moment – no interstate entries at Melbourne Royal and Collie entries at All Breeds shows seem to be well down. If this trend continues, we may need to review the prizes/sashes we offer.

Dog Sports figures are up on last year – heading in the right direction and although showing a small deficit, certainly well worth the effort.

Members' subscriptions are up from last year, but these figures can be distorted depending on how many pay in September vs October which is technically the next financial year. Although the numbers are small, new members joining seems to keep just ahead of those dropping out. Most of the Chatters being delivered via email has enabled us to avoid any increase in membership fees.

Fund raising, apart from AGM and Champ. Show raffles, has been non-existent. Huge Thank you to Graham Benson for donating the hamper for the Champ. Show raffle once again.

If we are to have an overseas judge, specific fund raising will need to be done. It has been done very successfully in the past so, if the will is there, it can be done again.

Deficit for the year is due largely to Handbook expenditure – printing costs being entirely in this financial year, while income was partially included last year.

The accounts show that the Club is in a sound financial position and should be able to remain so into the future.



DOG SPORTS STATS FOR 2023


We currently have around 30 Roughs and 12 Smooths trialling in various sports in Australia. To put this in perspective some 7 years ago I did the stats below and we had 16 Roughs and 5 Smooths trialling for a total of 38 titles for the year. Numbers are growing and are healthy and we have a lot of new handlers who have never trialled coming into the various sports. This is very encouraging. There are a number of baby dog and handler teams ready to dip their toes into the sports rings in the New Year, so we have hopes for even better results next year.

One thing to note is how top-heavy many sports have been this year. We had 5 Collies gain their Track and Search Grand champion titles, which is absolutely fantastic and something to be very proud of. While we all know Vicki Brown has done this before, titling three dogs in one season at this level is without doubt an amazing achievement. The other two handlers were tracking their first dogs at this level.

The other one was an Obedience Champion title achieved by Jackie Christensen in Queensland with her homebred Rough girl Lilli (Dual Ch (OC) Claiescotts Lilli O the Valley RN ADX JDX SN SPD TK.I HTM.I FS.N.) Another something to shout about as of all the performance Champion titles the OC is without doubt one of the more difficult to achieve. The evidence in this is that in 70 odd years we have only had 4 dogs gain the title. Jackie's Lilli is the 5th Collie in history to do this. We have a handful of open titled dogs, so fingers crossed that we won't have to wait another 20 odd years for the next one!
