Financial Year ended 30th September 2025

I present the Audited Accounts and Balance Sheet for the Financial Year ended 30th September 2025 to the Members.

Both Championship and Open Show income continued their downward trend, with lower entries BBQ income etc. and no raffle. Donations, however, saw a handy increase and there were lower costs for a local judge, BBQ supplies and catering expenses. Special Thank you to Sigrid and Sally for a great job with the catering.

The coming year will present a very different scenario with the expenses of an overseas judge, but a great start has been made with the Roxy Show Trolley raffle which netted a profit of \$2,483-80. Thank you to Kate and Sue.

Interest on the Term Deposit (Handbook funds) is not as exciting as it looks, with the Term Deposit currently running for 12 months c.f. much shorter terms previously.

Dog Sports figures are slightly skewed with income from Sprint Dog included in this year's figures while expenses will be in next year's. Regardless, this has proved a very popular and worthwhile addition to our calendar and will significantly boost the Dog Sports income.

Memberships have remained fairly stable with differences mainly due to when renewals were actually received – before or after 30th September.

While \$5,137.43 looks like a healthy surplus, it needs to be considered in the light of what is expected to be a fairly expensive year next year with an overseas judge. Next year's Balance Sheet will be interesting.



Rescue AGM Report 2024-2025

It has been – thankfully – a quiet year in rescue, with only two dogs needing to come into foster care.

You may remember the case of the young rough sable and white girl who was abandoned by the side of the road, with the previous owner taking her out of the car and driving off, leaving a kind Samaritan who witnessed the event to catch her and take her to the Lost Dog's Home in Cranbourne. Well, Lady (as it turned out her name was), did her time at the pound and when she wasn't claimed, she was desexed and turned over to our care.

Gorgeous, sweet girl, spent a few weeks with me – because of course she ended up with a mild dose of kennel cough. Once recovered, she went off to live on 60 odd acres out Ballarat way, with a male RC and two new people for company. Hazel, as she is now known, has dropped her considerable weight and is loving life.

Our second foster is, again, a sable and white female, by the name of Marlee, a 7 yr old who came to us as her elderly owner was struggling with health issues. She is currently in recovery from her spey, and has a wonderful home lined up in Mornington with a huge backyard and other dogs for company. She'll be on her way when the stitches come out and her vaccinations are done.

We run rescue on the sniff of an oily rag, and while rehoming fees go some way to recovering veterinary costs, it is our priority that dogs go to the right home. We don't want them back -and I do mean that in a good way. So keep an eye out for our annual calendars and throw some support our way if and when you can, it would be most appreciated.

On another note, Dog Lover's is on again this weekend at the Royal Melbourne Show grounds, and once again the collies will be there. So, if you are in the area stop past and say Hi, and give a dog or two a scratch behind the ear.

Dog Sports AGM Report 2025

What a fantastic year our collies have had! Dogs have titled from all over the country in multiple sports, with the new sport of Sprint Dog proving very popular. Many of the dogs competing are first timers to dog sports, along with their owners, and I hope that now they have been bitten by the sports bug they will continue on to other things. You never know...

The Collie Club Rally and Obedience trial was a great success way back when in December, with a total entry of 80 dogs (a decent turn out for a restricted to group trial) and a lovely turn out of collies, with some very promising newbies – watch this space! I am currently planning for the next one, on the 20th of December, and on the lookout as always, for help, raffle donations, and sash sponsorship.

We had 4 collies competing at the Royal Melbourne Show in Rally, for 6 quallies, and three titles, one of those being a Rally Champion, which also made Taisa the first collie in Australia to earn the title of Multi Champion.

The Collie Club held our very own SprintDog trial on the 4th of October at KCC which was very well attended. There were 11 roughs and 6 smooths, who collected 13 passes between them. There was also a total of 25 titles achieved on the day, with 84 quallies from 107 entries. Keeping the trial as a restricted to group also meant we could avoid the stampede at entries and gave anyone with a working dog an opportunity to enter. It was a shame the date clashed with General Specials Day at the Royal, however it was the only day left in October our very own judge Amy was free.
