Collie Rescue

Vale ~ Beauty 2008-28/12/2022

Beauty came to us at rescue a few months after the Black Saturday Fires on 9 Feb 2009. Beauty came to us as a result of the fires when the owners couldn't take her back in the aftermath after losing their home and backyard on that devastating day. She was boarded at Coldstream for some months, but when the owners found they couldn't provide her, her brother, and her pups with the home they deserved for years after, they made the hard decision to surrender Beauty and two of her pups to Coldstream, who in turn contacted us. She was the mother to three puppies, two of which came to rescue also. (One has since passed over rainbow bridge that I know of) Her brother and one of the pups stayed with the fire victim owners. Thank you to Dave for taking in Beauty and giving her a loving home for those many years after. I know it will be breaking his heart to say goodbye to his "Beauty." Below is Dave's lovely tribute to Beauty.

Beauty

The breed standard for rough Collies includes "A dog of great beauty," I would add "A dog you can be proud to own. An excellent companion."

Beauty came to me after the 2009 Bushfires. Her home had been destroyed in the fires. She had pups and was in care after the fires before becoming available for adoption through Collie Rescue. I needed a younger dog to continue Delta volunteering so Beauty got a new home.

Her new pack included two older Rough Collies and two Border Collies with these she enjoyed many runs up the bush, chasing the frisbee, trips in the car to sheepdog trials and training days. Also visits to Collie Shows where she was excited to see many other Collies.



At the 2022 Collie Show she saw Jackie and the Collie rescue lady who told me one of Beauty's pups had passed away a couple of years ago.



Delta visiting dogs visit people who are institutionalised and they look forward to dog visits. Beauty visited Providence old people's home and Merrimu services disability centre. One of Merrimu's clients had a terror of dogs, after observing Beauty over time he accepted her and was happy to hold her lead and talk to her. Some years after retiring from the Delta program, we met a Merrimu client and his carer the client was very excited to see Beauty again.

One by one of Beauty's pack members crossed the rainbow bridge. The last was Lucky the Border Collie, who crossed just before the Covid lockdowns. There was a lot of thunderstorm activity the following week and Beauty made an escape (a dog owner's nightmare!). She had never been worried by thunderstorms before. After 2 hours of searching, I went to the police. "If you see a Collie wandering around, please arrest her. She shouldn't be out!" I went home for a quick break and as I was leaving again some people asked me if I knew anyone with a collie. "Sure do!"

She had run up onto their balcony and was trying to get in the front door. "We took her down to our garage and put

her in our car, she seemed happy then" and no wonder the car was chevy corvette.

During the Covid lockdown years Beauty was my constant companion. Our Daily walks included Bald Hill with its panoramic views and the Lerderberg river to relax along.

Early in 2022 Magpie a Border Collie pup arrived, Beauty tolerated her and they were friends.

For the last 6 months Beauty had been sleeping in and slowing down on walks. We started doing out and back walks and letting Beauty do her own thing, meeting her on the way back. Her last good walk was at moon reserve, four days before her passing, also a little tottering walk near the river on her final trip to the vets.

Sharing time with Beauty has been a true blessing for which I will be forever thankful.
