## **TRAINING**

### **PLACE & TIME**

PLACE - Clark Reserve, St Lawrence Avenue (off Raby Road), Kearns

TIME - Monday Evenings - Kiosk opens at 7.00pm , Training between 7.30 to 8.30.

There is no training on Public Holidays or Extreme Weather. Extreme Weather includes continuous rain, thunder storms, whether raining or not & temperatures above 35 Deg.C after 6.30pm

A 4 week break over the Christmas period starting the 2nd Monday in December. Training recommencing again on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday in January.

## **DEFINITIONS**

If joining between 1<sup>st</sup> of July & 31<sup>st</sup> December a Full Years Membership applies.

If joining between 1<sup>st</sup> of January & the 1<sup>st</sup> of May (1 month grace given) a half Year Membership applies.

All existing Memberships, including those who joined between January & May will be due for renewal before 1<sup>st</sup> July.

## **YOUR DOG**

- All dogs must be Fully Vaccinated. A Current Vaccination certificates must be shown when submitting your signed Application for Membership and also when renewing your Membership each June. When mailing Applications, or Renewals, a photocopy of the vaccination certificate is acceptable.
- Vaccination requirements are C 4 as a minimum - **Parvo-virus, Hepatitis, Distemper & Kennel Cough**

## **TRAINING METHODS**

- Macarthur Dog Training Club, Inc uses **motivational (reward & praise) training only.**
- Solid leather or webbing collars are acceptable as are halties. The use of Body Harnesses or check chains is not encouraged.
- Food rewards can be any type of sausage, meat or softer doggy treats cut or broken up into small portions. Kibble should only be used if your dog is on a special diet.

## **EQUIPMENT**

- Cotton webbing lead to suit size of dog
- Solid or webbing collar
- Bumbag to hold food rewards
- Spare Plastic bag to dispose of any droppings

A range of equipment may be purchased on the grounds at near to cost prices.

## **MEMBERSHIP DEFINITIONS**

### **• FINANCIAL YEAR**

A Financial Year commences on the 1<sup>st</sup> of July, and terminates on the 30<sup>th</sup> of June in the following year.

### **• GENERAL MEMBERSHIP**

Any family member resident at the same address who is over the age of twelve (12) years. When voting on Club matters, a Family Membership entitles the members to one (1) vote as a Family unit.

### **• JUNIOR MEMBER**

A "Junior Member" defines a person over the age of twelve (12) years and under the age of Eighteen (18) years who has been admitted as a member of the club. Junior members are not entitled to vote on Club matters or hold any Club Committee Offices. These members will become eligible to vote and hold Club Committee Offices 3 months after their 18th birthday, where upon formal notice should be given to the Club that said member no longer holds Junior status.

### **• PENSIONER MEMBERSHIP**

Any person that holds a valid Aged Pensioner Card may apply for Pensioner Membership. A Pensioner Membership entitles the member to one vote.

Any member may include any number of dogs on their membership providing that proof of vaccination has been provided. New dogs may be added to a membership at any time under the same conditions as previously stated.

An additional membership fee IS NOT required when adding additional dogs.
