A Bull Terrier must obtain seven (7) points to be granted the ROM Certificate. At least one, three (3) point award and at least one, two (2) point award at Bull Terrier Specialist shows must be included. The other points may be taken from All Breeds Shows. Points must be obtained under separate judges.

After gaining the points as detailed above, the owner is to apply to the Secretary NBTCA in writing or electronically and include:

1. ROM Award cards (or photocopy or scan),
 2. A suitable photograph, and
 3. Copy or scan of Dogs Australia (ANKC) certified pedigree.
