## Qualified Gundog and Terrier Judge Bull Terrier ROM Judge

I am a qualified Gundog and Terrier judge, deeply involved in the pedigree dog world since 1995. My journey began with Labrador Retrievers, with our family's first Labrador quickly gaining his title, igniting our passion for showing and breeding. Over the years, I have also become significantly involved with Border Terriers for 19 years and, since 2012, Bull Terriers (and Miniatures), and most recently Parson Russell Terriers.

Under the CHANPEMA prefix, I bred my first litter in 1998 and have since titled over 25 Labradors and 25 Border Terriers, including six Supreme Champions. With my husband, Paul Haseldine, under the VEROLI prefix, we have titled multiple Bull Terriers (including Miniatures), achieving one Supreme Champion and ROM Champions, with others progressing towards titles. We have been breeding litters under the VEROLI prefix since 2013.

My experience spans over 25 years, making me a breed specialist for Labrador Retrievers, Border Terriers, and Bull Terriers. I am dedicated to the show ring, emphasizing health testing and the promotion of these breeds' outstanding qualities. My contributions extend internationally, having exported show dogs to New Zealand, Japan, and India, all of which have been titled and helped improve the breed in their respective countries. I have also attended prestigious shows such as CRUFTS and breed specialty shows in England, America, and New Zealand, and have shown my breeds at major national and specialty breed shows across Australia, earning multiple Specialty Best in Show and All Breeds awards.

My involvement extends beyond showing and breeding, as I actively participate in breed clubs and committees. I am a life member of the Junior Kennel Club and have held executive positions in several clubs, including the Labrador Retriever Club of SA, Gundog Club of SA, and German Shorthaired Pointer Club of SA. I am currently a committee member of the Bull Terrier Club of SA and have served as a Councillor on the DogsSA Council. I was also the Secretary of the National Bull Terrier Council (Australia) from 2017 until 2023.

While my initial passions were with other breeds, my main passion now lies with Bull Terriers and Bull Terriers (Miniatures), for which I am approved to award ROM points. In my short time as a qualified ROM Bull Terrier Judge, I have already judged specialties in multiple Australian states and New Zealand. I continue to enhance my knowledge of the breed by attending specialty shows as an exhibitor, judge, or spectator.

I look forward to judging more in Australia and around the world.
