The 21st Australian Biennial Bull Terrier Trophy Show

I was honoured to be invited to judge the Biennial National Trophies in Bull Terriers and Miniature Bull Terriers. There were some really super dogs and bitches in both breeds and plenty of depth in quality. Especially close decisions in the Mini bitch Trophy. This is great for the future of both breeds in Australia.

Baby Puppy Dog (2 entries)

1. Barrett's Briminie Loucypher. Compact white 5 months baby. Super head with fill. Super eye. Straight front & short back. Excellent bone. Moved freely.
2. Mc'Gowan's Bankabull One of The Boys. Powerful tricolour 17 weeks baby. Good head with lovely profile. Lovely reach of neck. Shapely forechest. Good bone. Feet could be tighter. Not as together as 1.

Minor Puppy Dog (1 entry)

1. Yeoh's Yandomir Larrikin Levi. Upstanding typy white puppy. Strong head with good fill and finish, mouthfault. Lovely reach of neck with straight front. Drove from behind. Super smart showboy. One to watch when he's older.

Puppy Dog (4 entries, 1 absent)

1. Sutcliffe's Semajon Devils Road. Eye catching super headed typy white puppy dog, 9 months old. Mouth fault. Lovely straight front with cat feet. Shapely throughout. Moved freely and with drive. A very promising virtuous puppy who I feel once matured will be one to watch.
2. Sarajeni Kennels Sarajeni Mustafa The Gansta. Compact red & white puppy dog 11 months old. Strong filled head with finish. Good bone & substance. Drives out.
3. Wright's Lowdina Yahoo Login. Typy white puppy dog, 10 months old. Nicely filled head with lovely profile. Mouth OK. Good reach of neck. Front needs to tighten.

Junior Dog (7 entries, 1 absent)

1. Hansen's Braxstar Cruisin For A Bruisin. Very typy eye-catching white dog. Super head filled and turned with wicked expression. Mouth good. Well made & shapely throughout. Very compact and balanced. Moved well in front and covered the ground. A virtuous dog with the wow factor. Ormandy Box Winner for Best Dog and Souperlative Box for Best Dog under 18 months.
2. Wiseman's Bulroarus Bobby Dazzler. Upstanding black brindle & white dog. Strong head with excellent fill up & unexaggerated profile. Mouth OK. Lovely straight front with excellent reach of neck. Powerful & shapely throughout. Moved with drive freely covering the ground. Preferred the balance of 1.

3. Humphries Bullroy Rip T Crack. Cobby compact white dog. Super profile and good fill with wicked eye. Mouth good. Not as mature as 1 & 2.

Intermediate Dog (6 entries, 2 absent)

1. Bullpatchy Kennels' Bullpatchy Super Superlative. Powerful masculine black brindle & white dog. Power packed head with excellent turn and strong underjaw. Wicked eye. Mouth good. Super straight front & neat feet. Good turn of stifle. Moved freely & with drive. A super dog who could carry a tad less weight and could make more of himself.
2. Ralph's Shadbraye Kid Rock. Chunky brindle and white dog. Strong head with fill & finish. Lovely reach of neck with shapely forechest. Moved freely and covered the ground. Could make more of himself.
3. Lachmund's Ch Balgay Sunrise Sid. Cobby white dog. Strong filled head lacking profile with wicked eye. Mouth OK. Decent front with shapely forechest and tidy feet. Prefer shorter back. Moved better going than coming.

Australian Bred Dog (4 entries, 2 absent)

1. Matsen & Balsillie's Supreme Ch Satori Magic Mike. Masculine powerhouse brindle & white dog. Super head filled right up with lovely turn. Mouth good. Wicked expression. Straight front with cat feet. Holds topline on the move. Needs more rear angulation. Covers the ground on the move but close in front and behind. Hard to believe he is nearly 7 years old.
2. Jones' Ch Lowdina Interface. Quality white dog. Nice profile with decent fill up. Wicked eye. Prefer more underjaw. Mouth good. Fairly well made throughout. Prefer more of him. Not as masculine as 1.

Open Dog (5 entries, 1 absent)

1. Schofield's Stardom Demons Disciple. Cobby compact white dog. Super head with lovely profile and good fill. Wicked expression. Straight front with shapely forechest. Prefer more turn of stifle. Powerful body but seemed to lack bone. Moved better in front than behind.
2. Dowall's Jacamar Fury Road. Powerful red & white dog. Super head with turn & fill up. Lovely earset. Good reach of neck with straight front and neat feet. Prefer a shorter back and more hind angulation. Moved well, drove from behind and fairly parallel.
3. Matsen & Balsillie Ch Kupala Kapstone. Quality white dog. Nice profile with decent fill and wicked eye. Prefer ears set more on top of head. Straight front with neat feet. Moved freely.

Baby Puppy Bitch (3 entries)

1. McGowans Bankabull Piece of My Heart. Quality white baby puppy bitch. Super head with wicked eye. Shapely body with lovely angulation. Moved freely.
2. Handsaker's Pondera Hot Chilli Woman. Cobby red & white puppy bitch. Long head with good profile and decent fill. Straight front with neat feet. Moved freely.
3. McGowan's Bankabull Heartbreaker. Fairly balanced & well made white puppy bitch. Good head but preferred the heads of 1 & 2 at this age. Moved freely.

Minor Puppy Bitch (1 entry)

1. Yeoh's Yandomir Shez The One. Top quality 6 months white puppy with lots of promise. Lovely head with wicked expression. Straight front with neat feet and excellent reach of neck. Moved better going than coming but covered the ground. Just needs time then should be one to watch.

Puppy Bitch (5 entries)

1. Bullpatchy Kennels Bullpatchy Violet Moon. Ultra typy black brindle & white bitch. Super powerpacked head with wicked expression. Balanced and well made throughout. Excellent bone. Moved fairly parallel. Winner of Souperlative Box for Best Bitch under 18 months.
2. Yeoh's Yandomir Miss Alaska. Shapely white puppy bitch. Feminine head with decent fill & wicked eye. Well made throughout. Moved better in front than behind but covered the ground.
3. Bottomley's Unthinkabull Mine Power. Cobby white bitch with super profile and wicked eye. Good bone. Needs to carry less weight to improve overall outline. Covered the ground on the move.

Junior Bitch (11 entries)

1. Wiseman's Bulroarus White Russian. Cobby typy white bitch. Super head turned and filled with wicked eye. Straight front with neat feet. Compact body. Prefer more hind angulation but drove from behind.
2. Hargreaves' Bluereaper Diamond In The Rough. Cobby compact white bitch. Strong filled head with good profile and wicked eye. Fairly well made throughout and best mover in this class. Doesn't make the most of herself.
3. Matsen & Balsillie Huatare Shez Da Bom. Powerful upstanding white bitch. Super turned head with wicked expression. Straight front, prefer tighter feet. Shapely throughout. Moved freely.

Intermediate Bitch (9 entries)

1. Campbell's Hellofabull Wild Ego. Upstanding shapely brindle & white bitch. Sweeping profile with decent fill up. Straight front with neat feet & short back. Prefer lower tailset. Moved well & with drive. Super showgirl.
2. McGowan's Ch Tenaz Shez Daddys Girl. Powerful black brindle & white bitch. Long head with sweeping profile. Straight front with good hind angulation. Not as compact as 1. Needs to make more of herself. Covered the ground on the move.
3. Dowall's Jacamar Pogue Mahone. Cobby red & white bitch. Lovely head turned and powerpacked. Straight front with neat feet. Tends to lose topline on the move. Moved freely.

Australian Bred Bitch (5 entries, 1 absent) Top quality bitches with very close decisions

1. Wiseman's Bulroarus Common Ground. Big upstanding powerhouse white with tri eyepatch. Lovely profile with good fill and wicked eye. Fairly well made through out with shapely forechest. Good reach of neck. Could carry a few pounds less. Moved fairly parallel and covered the ground.
2. Thiemann's Harrick Miss Money Penny. Cobby compact white bitch with tri eye patch. Lovely turned head with decent profile & wicked eye. Well made throughout. Moved better in front than behind and covered the ground. Could make more of herself.

3. Hansen's Braxstar Harlem Back Girl. Super eyecatching white bitch. Super turned & filled head. Undershot mouth. Shapely & well made throughout and moved accordingly. Showed really well.

Open Bitch (7 entries, 2 absent)

1. Humphrey's Bullroy Buddie Crazy. Outstanding typy white bitch with dazzling white coat. Superb turned head with lovely fill up & ultra wicked expression. Really compact and well made throughout. Lovely reach of neck and shapely forechest. Super mover, moved parallel and with drive. Super showgirl. Winner of Ormandy Box for Best Bitch.
2. Hansen's Braxstar Batchelor Girl. Powerful brindle & white bitch. Super turned head with good fill. Shapely forechest with straight front & neat feet. Moved better going away than coming but covered the ground.
3. Schofield's Stardom Tiger Lily. Compact shapely white bitch. Long head with profile, prefer more strength under the eye. Straight front with neat feet. Well made throughout and moved fairly parallel. Could make more of herself.
