I was Secretary of the National Bull Terrier Council (Australia) from 1994 to 2003 and 2006 to 2017 and President since 2019. I have also been Secretary of the Australian Capital Territory Bull Terrier Club since 1990.

Over the years, I have attended USA Silverwood weekends, the Montgomery County cluster shows, Westminster Show in New York and then in the UK, the BTC (UK) Trophy Show, Crufts and Bull Terrier Championship Shows.

Assignments include Montgomery County Kennel Club (USA), Santa Barbara Kennel Club (USA), Futurity Sweepstakes for the Bull Terrier Club of America, the 'Egg Head Competition' for the Miniature Bull Terrier Club of America, North Island Bull Terrier Club and Championship and Open Bull Terrier Shows in Australia.

I am currently listed on the Bull Terrier Club (UK) Overseas Judges list and the South East Counties Bull Terrier Club (UK) A3 List.
