My love and interest for Bull Terriers began at the age of 7 when my family got our first Bull Terrier, and I have never been without them since.

I attended my first specialty show to watch in 2001. In 2003, I owned my first Bull Terrier, 'Maolmhin Flirtation,' and by 2005, I handled a Bull Terrier at the Trophy Show in South Australia. Since then, I have been actively handling and attending specialty shows. I have been breeding and showing Bull Terriers and Bull Terrier Miniatures since 2005. Since late 2012, my wife and I have established our kennel, Veroli Bull Terriers and Bull Terrier Miniatures.

Some of the highlights of my time owning, breeding, and exhibiting Bull Terriers and Bull Terrier Miniatures include:

- **Breeding and Handling Success:** I have bred or handled over 10 Bull Terrier Miniatures to their Australian Champion titles, with two of those dogs obtaining their ROM titles. These dogs have won numerous in-show awards.
- **Achievements with Bull Terriers:** I have bred and/or handled over 15 Bull Terriers to their Australian Championship titles. Among these, one obtained his ROM title and became a Supreme Champion, with several others achieving Grand Championship and Supreme titles.
- **Specialty Level Success:** At specialty shows, I have won Best in Show, Runner-Up in Show, numerous class awards, and many ROM points for various Bull Terriers and Bull Terrier Miniatures.
- **All Breeds Shows:** At all breeds shows, I have won multiple Best in Show and Runner-Up in Show awards, as well as countless Best in Group and class awards.

### Judging Experience

Since gaining my ROM Licence in 2015, I have judged specialty Bull Terrier and Miniature Bull Terrier shows in multiple states of Australia and multiple times in New Zealand. I look forward to judging more in the future and continuing to contribute to the breed.
