

I was born into the show world and am proud to be a third-generation exhibitor, raised in a family where Royal and Specialty show dates were checked before booking weddings. When I met my husband, Adam he was obsessed with Bull Terriers and I said that if we were getting one it would be a purebred so I could at least show it. And so, my connection to Bull Terriers began in 2002 when my husband and I purchased our somewhat flawed but very loved, first Bull Terrier, “Chaos”, starting my lifelong obsession with this incredible breed.

We successfully campaigned Chaos to his Grand Championship title, and since then, Bull Terriers have always been part of our home. My greatest success is with Gr Ch Honhazsta Angel O The North “Kismet” who we travelled with to specialities, royals and the big shows interstate and she was a very successful bitch. She was to become our foundation bitch. Under the ‘Supremecy’ prefix, we bred three litters, with our last in 2013 producing two titled girls. I found breeding emotionally challenging — shedding tears beside the whelping box — and so realised my true calling is providing an outstanding show home where others entrust us with their Bull Terriers for campaigning for the show ring. We have never been without a bull terrier on the couch, but haven’t actively shown bull terriers since the retirement of our last homebred girl. Our Bull Terriers stay with us for life, and so for the last 5 years, we found ourselves with a couch full of old dogs who were past showing. But we remained actively involved in the breed attending numerous specialities and maintaining our connection to the breed, traveling to Crufts in 2023 and Westminster in 2022 where we sat ringside to admire the Bull Terriers. One of the highlights of my judging career so far was being invited to judge the QLD Bull Terrier Open Show in June, 2022.

I am now currently a licensed Championship show judge for the Terrier Group and have open show status for my second love, the Non-Sporting Group. I have also extended my judging qualifications to include open show status for the Toy group and this year have added Working Dogs.

Bull Terriers are and will forever be my heart breed.
