I would like to begin this critique by offering an immense thank you to the Club for this invitation, it was an honour to be asked, and an honour to assess the beautiful dogs that appeared under me today. I am so grateful to each and every exhibitor that took the time to present their Staffords for my opinion, something that no judge should ever take lightly or for granted. I had the best time here, superb hospitality, wonderful accommodation and a truly fabulous time in Australia.

The level of quality was nothing short of excellent and I found some beautiful dogs and bitches here that truly pleased my little Stafford heart. If I were to offer any advice after judging it would be that some of the best ones were not in the condition that I would expect at this level of competition and whilst this does not make them any less in quality, it does impact on their chances at the death, when up against other class winners who are in better nick. Lacking muscle tone, and long nails will be held against them in the final line up. Mouths also need some looking at, I did find more than one very nice Stafford with converging canines, and whilst I am in no means a tooth fairy and an 'untidy' mouth will not sway me from an otherwise super dog, converging canines are a no no for me. That said, I was delighted with my top winners, all of them having true type, bone, rib and substance, keep doing what you're doing!!

Baby Puppy Dog

1st Irelands Stafflex Check Out My Socks

Super smart BB baby of 3.5 months. Ample bone for his frame, a nice straight front, compact neat feet. He has attractive white markings, and lovely pigmentation. He has a very nice topline for one so young, and the depth of his body looks promising, he moved soundly with a well carried tail, he was a lovely start to my day.

2nd Edwards Sookalott Letsgetthepartystarted

A dark red puppy of 4.5 months with a touch more bone than 1 but a little less sound in topline at this stage of development, and a touch longer coupled, however he has a beautiful well developed head and a gorgeous expression. He has a well placed, round eye a good stop, nice strong muzzle. Promising puppy.

3rd Hartnetts Anvilhart The Crown Is Mine

A red smut pup of barely over 3 months. He has wonderful pigmentation, good bone, with width and depth to his front. He held his topline beautifully on the move, and his angulation looks promising but 1 and 2 were more developed in the head at this stage and had neater feet.

Minor Puppy Dog

1st Harrison's Skybreaker Not My Circus

6.5 month old black brindle boy. Beautifully handled, with the makings of a truly beautiful head. The darkest of eyes, with the correct amount of width between them so that they do not look alien but are wide apart, his foreshell is deep, and his stop is pronounced. His muzzle length is perfect, being neither short nor long, but blunt. His cheek muscles are forming, his underjaw is good, and the ears I expect to be lovely when his head finishes development. He has enough bone for his frame, his feet are fine, he has plenty of body and he moved very well in profile. His front movement is still that of a puppy but muscle tone and conditioning should tighten that up. A super handsome boy, look forward to the finished product. Minor Puppy In Show

2nd Koendidda Kennels Koendidda Rhum Dancer (AI)

A black brindle puppy of 7 months, less mature than 1st, he has good bone, width of body and substance and very nice feet. An attractive expression, super dark eye, a strong muzzle, ears will settle when head and teeth are finished. Movement was ok for a baby.

3rd Merediths Beddah Jamaican Me A Rockstar

A red smut pup with white, at 6.5 months. He has a more functional type of head than 1 and 2, broad skull, powerful muzzle, a dark eye and well carried ears. He is well up to size at this age, and has excellent angulation both ends, he held his topline and moved ok

Puppy Dog

1st Amos Verysharp The Devil Inside

A BB pup of 10.5 months. A strong head on this lad, short, deep muzzle, deep stop, dark eyes and neat ears. His head could be a shade cleaner but he does exude type. He has good solid bone, is well off for rib, and has substance. A broad front, a well carried and correctly set on tail, short strong hocks and his movement was ok.

2nd Heards Toploader Brindle Hustler (AI)

Almost 11 month old BB pup. I did prefer the head style on this chap, cleaner and more traditional in style. A dark eye of correct size and shape, beautiful ears, a good stop, with a broad deep underjaw. He has a good weight of bone, good depth to body but was slightly narrower in front. Moved ok.

3rd Shadowstaff Kennels Shadowstaff I Am The Shadows

11 month old BB pup. Shorter in stature than first 2, he has lovely bone, good width and depth and he has substance. He is a little heavier in ear than first 2, but a typey attractive Stafford puppy.

Junior Dog

1st Darts Vagastaff God Of Mischief

A red fawn, bang on standard, dog of 15 months. Truly cracking construction here, well angulated both ends, super topline, he is compact, has a nice tuck up, correctly set and carried tail, short strong hocks, good pasterns, feet are ok, his neck is of correct length, ie "rather short" His head is very attractive with a short blunt muzzle, which could be cleaner, this may improve with further head development, I would love to see how this dog finishes. Junior In Show

2nd Lowes CH Likalot Punky Brewster

A lovely expression on this almost 17 month old BB and white chap. A beautifully balanced head piece, with a dark round eye, good muzzle length, and a broad skull. He has enough bone for his size, good angulation, good topline, correct tailset, moved ok. His nails did need attention.

3rd Radcliffes Borstaff Jack None Reacher

17 month old dark brindle with flashy white markings. He has good bone rib and substance. I really liked his head shape, he has a short blunt muzzle, He is a standard sized, typical Stafford, with width and depth at the front, and short strong hocks at the back.

Intermediate Dog

1st Merediths Beddah Malibudreams

A white and red pied dog who is bang on standard for size. He has a beautiful, clean head with enough stop, correct length of muzzle, and neat enough ears. He has a nice straight, broad front, with depth of brisket, and good width. A well developed ribcage, good topline, close coupled, correctly set and carried tail, and nice movement, he won here by virtue of his compactness and width of front.

2nd Sings Ch Pranksta The Devil Has A Name (AI)

A powerful BB dog, in cracking condition. A typical, attractive head piece with a well shaped and placed eye, nice ear carriage, a strong muzzle and an appealing expression. He has plenty of bone, good rib and substance, a very handsome young man who moved well. A super close call here as this is a classy looking animal.

3rd Darts Ch Vagastaff Back In Black

A strong, standard sized BB dog. He has plenty of bone, a nice broad front, and great weight of bone. He has a nice type of head, with dark round eye, nice ears, a good expression but would like more fill under the eye and a stronger foreface. He has a good topline, rear angulation and tailset, he moved ok.

Graduate Dog

1st Crumptions Jonthill The Coalminer

Very appealing head and expression on this classy brindle and white pied dog. He has exquisite pigmentation, well placed dark, round eyes, neat ears, a good stop and a strong, clean foreface. His muzzle is of correct length, and clean with a good underjaw. A lovely straight, well boned front, his topline is great, his angulation is spot on, for me, I would just prefer him a shade broader throughout.

2nd Baxters Boldhart The Devil Strikes Back

This is a standard sized, very typical BB dog. He has an attractive head piece, with a dark eye, a clean foreface, and enough underjaw. He has a lovely weight of bone throughout, very nice feet, a shapely body with good rib, good substance, a well carried tail and correct short strong hocks, A nice dog all over.

3rd Roebigs Bxact The Soul Taker

A topsize red fawn dog. Lovely head shape, with neat ears, short blunt muzzle, and a good stop that all give a nice expression but I would prefer it to be cleaner. He has plenty of bone, a good straight

front, feet are ok but lack pigment on the nails, good rib and substance but is a little longer cast than 1 and 2 which showed in his movement.

Limit Dog

1st Lomaxs Kaleida Lightnin Strikes Twice

Stunning white dog, a gorgeous head with superb pigment, a good stop, well developed cheek muscles, short blunt muzzle, a darker eye would top it off. He has a lovely front, displaying width and depth with a good weight of bone. He has a nice topline and good depth to his body, angulation is slightly straight both ends but the dog is well balanced so this has no impact on his movement which was good, maintaining his level topline throughout.

2nd Irelands Stafflex Heskeys Journey

A very handsome, standard sized BB dog with a little white. I really liked the overall look of this dog, very nice traditional breed type. A lovely expressive head, with well placed ears, a good stop, blunt muzzle, very clean, and good cheek muscles. He has the right amount of bone for his frame, and presents a powerful picture, close decision with 1st just swaying it with his slightly broader front, but this one appealed to me very much as a good honest Staffordshire Bull Terrier of quality.

3rd Koendidda Kennels Chapmeek Ice Patrol At Ashstaff (Imp UK)

A lovely, typical, well built bb pied dog. He is very well boned, has super substance, width and depth to his strong straight front, and a good ribcage. He is well let down at the hock, has a good topline and carried his tail correctly on the move.

Australian Bred Dog

1st and Reserve Challenge Dog – Runner Up Best In Show Luggs Borstaff Neverending Story

My notes began with “YUM” A gorgeous standard sized red pied dog, who was just SO sound throughout. A lovely front, with width and depth, and strong straight bone. He has neat feet, well angulated shoulders, and a very nice shapely body with good rib. He is light in the loin, has a super topline, and he has a powerful rear end with short strong hocks, which drove him around the ring beautifully. His head is lovely good broad skull, deep enough in stop, strong muzzle and neat ears all add up to a lovely expression. A really nice Stafford, congratulations. Australian Bred in Show.

2nd Darragh and Faamita Usherin Pick Your Battle

I was spoilt in this class, as I really did like this chap as well. A standard sized BB dog with a little white, who has fabulous breed type. A lovely clean head with a super expression. He has a dark eye, good depth to skull, short blunt muzzle, strong foreface and well developed cheeks. He has a very good front, broad enough with good bone and width. Rib and substance ideal for his size, he was well angulated and he moved well.

3rd Horleys Ch Pepstaff How U Like Me Now

Powerful looking typical BB dog, a truly classic Stafford head piece, with correct width between the eyes, ideal length of muzzle, and a very lovely expression. The eye could be a shade darker but does not detract from the quality. I liked his weight of bone, his good rib and his substance, a slightly broader front would appeal to me but he is in super condition and moved well.

Open Dog

At this point, I was thinking it will take something special to top my Aus Bred dog, and there it was....

1st Dog Challenge and Best In Show Coetzers Ch Zeracious Onthemoney

This one was literally designed with me in mind, I could actually have fallen over when I laid eyes on him.

A stunning, deep red with extensive white markings, Spot on standard sized, exudes breed type from every pore. He has a beautiful, clean, chiselled shapely head. The white on his muzzle not reaching quite all the way back to his foreface can fool you into thinking it's a touch too short, it is not, put your hands on and it is perfection. Depth to skull and muzzle is ideal, so well balanced. A lovely depth and width to stop, beautiful foreface, blunt muzzle and great width and depth to the jaw. Neatest of ears, well developed cheeks and a nice dark eye. His front is beautiful, correct width and depth, straight well boned legs and lovely neat feet. His rib is wonderful, it is deep and broad and of the correct length, his topline was perfect at all times. He is well angulated with short strong hocks, excellent depth of thigh, a well set and carried tail and all of this was topped off with superb pigmentation and his lovely condition. Congratulations on breeding a superb specimen of the breed.

Open In Show

2nd Koendidda Kennels Ch Koendidda Onya Birri

A handsome topsized pied dog with lovely pigmentation, a well shaped head with good skull, lovely ears and a nice expression. He has lovely bone, a good width of front, nice neat feet, a lovely ribcage and carried a good level topline. Good angulation fore and aft, a well balanced dog who moved well, was in lovely condition, active and agile came to mind.

3rd Lee Molru Throwing Shapes (Imp Irl)

An all round good quality, typical Stafford. A modern type of head, with a short blunt muzzle, depth throughout, neat ears and a good expression. He has a rather short, powerful neck, has good rib bone and substance, powerful rear quarters, with short strong hocks.

Baby Puppy Bitch

1st Brooks Cyprustaff Justlikethis

A super smart little baby, beautiful head developing, with an already lovely shape to her body, compact and broad throughout, lovely angulation, she held her topline at all times and moved with a confidence that belied her 4 short months of age. Lovely promising puppy. Baby Puppy In Show

2nd Chivers Vagastaff Gayles Gift

Another nice red puppy, at just over 4 months. Also showing a nicely developing head shape, with a beautiful dark round eye. A little longer cast than 1 but she also shows lots of promise.

3rd Coulsons Lilrock Never Da Devil

5.5 months old pretty, clean BB baby. She has a lovely head shape, neat ears and a dark eye lending themselves to a beautiful expression. Nice body shape developing, she has plenty of bone for her frame, just preferred the slightly broader fronts on 1 and 2 at this stage of their development.

Minor Puppy Bitch

1st Hears Toploader Black Chrome (AI)

Almost 9 month old, super pretty BB and white bitch. A lovely clean head with a dark round eye, strong foreface and neat enough ears. She is well balanced with good rib, bone and substance, and has nice feet. She moved well, and carried her tail correctly, lovely puppy.

2nd Edwards Sookalott Light My Way

A lovely head and expression on this pretty, red 7 month old puppy. She has lovely ears when she shows them to you, super rib, bone and substance, just preferred the feet and pigmentation of 1st.

Puppy Bitch

1st Knights Grayleigh Chokolat Mudshake

A super pretty, standard sized, brindle bitch with nice white markings. Almost 10 months old, I was quite taken with this lovely feminine puppy. A beautiful head, with a lovely shape and size to her eye, good width and depth throughout the head, short blunt muzzle, and a gorgeous expression. Good bone rib and substance and she is JUST wide enough for her frame. Moved very nicely for a baby. Puppy In Show

2nd Heards Toploader Velvetrevolver

A 9 months old, black brindle, standard sized puppy. Again, a pretty girl, with a nice expression dark eye a good stop and correct muzzle length. She could be very slightly broader in front but has plenty of time for this to develop, and she has good rib, a level topline, carried her tail correctly and moved like a happy puppy should.

3rd Roebigs Bxact The Knockout

A super headed red bitch of 10 months who has the loveliest dark round eye with a melting expression. Her head is clean enough, she has a good stop, depth to skull and a short strong muzzle, ears are ok. Her front is good, broad and deep, feet are a touch flat and nails lack pigmentation. She has a very nice shapely body with good rib and substance, she had a level topline on the move but was a shade longer coupled than 1 and 2.

Junior Bitch

1st Szirer and Luggs Borstaff Miss Pickles

A very pretty, standard sized brindle and white bitch of 17 months. She is powerful yet retains femininity. Gave me a bit of a headache as she was overweight, however, she CAN lose weight, and type wins. She has a great front, plenty of bone, with a deep brisket and correct width. She has a rather short, powerful neck, a good topline, a broad ribcage could be found under the extra substance, and she carried her tail correctly. She has a beautiful typical head, devoid of any kind of exaggeration. She could have a little more strength at the rear which should come with better fitness. She is worth the work.

2nd Koendidda Kennels Jonthill Buckle Up Buttercup (AI)

Nearly 16 months old, beautiful dark red bitch with a black mask. This was a really close call as I loved this one, very pretty, classic head shape, beautiful expression, lovely round eye perfectly placed. She has the right amount of bone and substance for her frame, enough depth at the front and lovely feet. She moved well, and carried her tail correctly, she was in beautiful condition I just preferred the width of front on one and her slightly more positive topline.

3rd Rasch Ch Anvilhart What You Wish For

An attractive, topsize BB bitch with white. A typical Stafford bitch, lovely head with neat ears, decent stop, strong muzzle and good depth to underjaw. She has plenty of strength throughout. Good bone, substance and rib, nice depth to body, good topline and short strong hocks. Moved well.

Intermediate Bitch

1st and Reserve Challenge McBrides Ch Brohez Queens Gambit (AI)

A quality, standard sized BB bitch who has a lovely typical head shape, a dark eye, short strong muzzle, good cheeks and her head is clean. Ears are perhaps a touch high set but are small and rosed. She has ideal bone rib and substance for her frame, a broad deep front and a good ribcage. She has good rear angulation, neat feet, a good tail, all round a lovely typical Stafford bitch who moved well and was well deserving of RCC. Intermediate In Show

2nd Livingstones Likalot License To Party

A powerful, topsize BB bitch. She exudes feminine strength, has a beautiful classic head shape, with a lovely expression, small neat ears, dark round eye, and a strong foreface. Good depth of stop, clean blunt muzzle, and good cheeks. Super bone, rib and substance, straight broad front, nice neat feet, a strong rear, well carried tail and positive movement.

3rd Doller Lekston Pretty As A Picture

Another nice BB bitch. She has a typical unexaggerated head, with good depth to skull and stop, clean strong foreface and muzzle. She is well angulated and has a good topline, just a little longer cast than 1 and 2.

Graduate Bitch

1st Lomax Usherin whats Poppin

A really pretty BB and white bitch. Beautiful expression, well set ears, deep broad skull, lovely dark round eye, strong foreface, short muzzle with deep underjaw. Rather short neck, well laid shoulder, broad in front with good bone and nice feet. She had a good topline, correct angulation, and her tailset and carriage were good. Moved nicely. Graduate In Show

2nd Jonthill Winnie Wildfire

A standard sized, deep red bitch with white socks. A beautiful feminine head and expression, dark mask, neat ears and correct muzzle length. Eye could be darker but is well placed and round and of good size. She has a powerful neck, a good topline, enough bone, rib and substance, could be closer coupled. Moved well.

3rd Koendidda Kennels Koendidda Lilylace

Shade more terrier to this super pretty bitch. At only 13 months, she has lots of maturing to do, but has all the right bits to mature well. A deep skull, good depth to stop and skull, slightly flighty in ear but they may settle as her head finishes. She has good bone, a straight, broad front with depth of brisket. Nice feet, well angulated both front and rear.

Limit Bitch

1st Roebigs Bxact Shake Datazz Forme

Very beautiful headed red bitch. It is deep, broad, lovely dark round eye, strong foreface, correct muzzle length and relatively clean. She has a nice front, good feet tho nails could be darker, a good topline and a compact body. She is solid throughout, with good rib bone and substance. Limit In Show

2nd Brandrick Seighford Amarula On Ice (AI)

Absolutely cracking body on this black and white pied bitch. Good weight of bone, well angulated both ends, broad front with depth to brisket, lovely ribcage, close coupled, neat feet, rather short in neck, good tailset, moved well, just couldn't match 1 in head and expression. Beautifully put together bitch.

3rd Livingstone Likalot Sheez Lethal (AI)

A standard sized BB bitch of good type. Lovely weight of bone, well ribbed, good angulation and topline. Her head is very nice, with a good foreface, dark round eye, good stop, and neat ears. She just a touch longer coupled than 1 and 2

Australian Bred Bitch

1st and Bitch Challenge Lee Ch Zaharastaff Beautiful Crazy

Stunning red and white bitch, feminine with strength throughout. Truly beautiful head, with width and depth to her skull, stop and underjaw. Melting dark round eye perfectly set in the skull, and a muzzle that is blunt and of correct length. Her head is clean, her ears lovely, and her cheek muscles well developed. She has a rather short, powerful neck, broad front with deep brisket, great weight of bone, her feet are good enough, she has super rib, is close enough in coupling, she is well developed in the rear and is well let down at the hock. To be critical, she is a touch over angulated at the back but we are here to award quality and she has it in bucket loads, a genuinely beautiful Stafford to whom I was delighted to award Bitch Challenge.

2nd Reid Ch Zeracious Sudden Impact

A very lovely white bitch. Beautiful head shape, deep skull, good cheeks, short blunt muzzle with lovely depth to underjaw. Slightly flighty in ear. Good weight of bone, broad front, nice feet, good depth to body, a little longer coupled than 1st. She has good rib, correct tailset, and short strong hocks.

3rd Anvilhart Kennels Anvilhart Canya Keepa Secret

Cracking shade of brindle to this beautiful bitch of traditional type. Beautiful Stafford head with no exaggeration, lovely eye shape and expression, powerful muzzle, and neat in ear. A wide deep front with great bone, lovely rib a good topline, and well let down in the hock.

Open Bitch

1st Major Sup Ch Kabere Yamademegofullninja

A clean, stylish BB bitch. She has a very nice head and expression, nice dark round eye, neat ears, good stop, correct muzzle length and enough underjaw. She has the right amount of bone for her frame, good rib and well developed rear quarters. She is well angulated, has a good tail set and she moved well.

2nd Livingstone Ch Likalot Kingdoms Protector

Quite a similar style of bitch to 1st, slightly broader throughout but 1 was closer coupled and had the more appealing expression for me. However, she too is a pretty bitch, with a nice clean head, neat ears, rather short in neck, well laid shoulders, good straight bone and neat feet. She had a good topline, correct tailset and she moved well.

3rd Coetzer Ch Zeracious Phoenix Warrior

A lovely BB bitch stronger all round, with good weight of bone, depth and width to body throughout, a lovely head with nice stop and good foreface, she is well angulated but wasn't as together on the move as 1 and 2 today.

Neuter Dog

1st Mays Kimbastaff Creating Chaos

Standard sized mahogany brindle dog of good type. He has good bone, rib and substance, a nice straight front, nice feet, a decent topline and short strong hocks. He is as mad as a box of frogs but we're not here to judge behaviour and I saw enough to happily give him this class. I bet he is fun to have around!

2nd Treadwells Neut Ch Kimbastaff Doo In It Solo

I found this dog to be similar in type to 1, they are indeed half brothers. This chap also has good rib, bone and substance and has a nice, typical head and expression, however, 1 was slightly broader and closer coupled.

3rd Sorensen Keelford Zeppelins Demise WWPD JC

A very soundly constructed, topsized red fawn dog. He has just enough bone for his size, he is well angulated front and back, a level topline, very neat feet, and a typical old school type of Stafford head piece, nice round eye, well set ears and good depth to underjaw. Moved nicely.

Neuter Bitch

1st Treadwells Ch Kimbastaff Doo It With Style

A very nice standard sized, typical DB bitch with a good head shape, correct stop, clean foreface, a broad and deep skull and a nice expression, she is sound of body with good bone, nice feet, width to the front and good rib. Moved Ok. Neuter In Show

2nd Lee Ch Zaharastaff Empower Me

A very deep red and white bitch, at 9.5 years old you can see she had a classic head shape, with enough stop, lovely dark round eye, good ears, nice blunt muzzle of good length, a super clean foreface. Rather short in neck, well developed font, good weight of bone, lovely topline and tailset, she moved very well. Carrying a little extra weight.

3rd Dixon Kaleida Get The Party Started

White bitch with ticking. Lovely headed bitch, good skull, neat ears, short strong muzzle, lovely dark round eye with great pigment. She has good substance, is well off for rib and bone but a touch upright in angulation.



First of all I would like to say a big thank you to Staffordshire Bull Terrier Club of Victoria Inc who gave me this opportunity and invited me to judge their championship show and for the warm welcome I received. I would like to thank everyone for giving me a wonderful entry, and accepting my decisions in a good sportsmanship like manner, it was very much appreciated. Special thanks to my ring stewards for their help throughout the day and kept the ring running smoothly.

Overall, the quality of entered dogs was of an extremely high level. General observations found no breathing issue, there were some misplaced lower canines. I saw some very narrow underjaws, which is, in my opinion, more and more present in the breed. I saw many narrow fronts, longer backs and no rib – and I think this is another problem in the breed. Most of dogs were in good condition and movements was good. Feet and nails need to improve, the whole picture of the dog will be much better in many dogs, if they want to compete for better placements and top honours. I want to say a big thank you to all exhibitors, who listen to my 3 wishes, when I asked no running in the ring, no feeding dogs in the ring and walk with your dog on a free leash. I am sorry, but I really do not like this 3 ring manners which came to our breed from all breed handlers and judges

Baby Puppy Dog (4,1)

1. A. Ireland / Stafflex Check Out My Socks – Lovely black puppy with whiter front paws when compare to the back. White chest. Balanced frame, with lovely dark black eyes, that nicely frame the face with no excess skin around the whole head. His teeth are just changing. Just right strength in neck with no excess wrinkles. Nicely strong bones, appropriate front width for his age range. His body is clean throughout and developing lovely for his age. Short

coupled, shows ample rib for his age, level top line. Well bent stifle and correct tail carriage. This very smart puppy moved well and I was pleased to award him Best Baby Puppy in show.

2. D.&K. Edwards / Sookalott Letgetthpartystarted – lovely red with all changed teeth, excluding canines. Very nice head expression, dark eyes, dark mask. Nice wide front. Lovely forequarters, head developing nicely. His neck flows well into his shoulders. He held topline on the move with tail coming straight off the topline. Good depth of chest, adequate turn of stifle. Showed well. Just a little bit lighter bone than the first one.
3. M. Hartnett / Anvilhart The Crown is Mine – Good size pup in sable colour. Little bit lighter in bone than first two. Nice head and expression with dark eyes. Plenty of width to front. Feet a little flat with open toes, but with more road work and proper nail cut this can be fixed. Loved his straight back, just little bit sloped croup. Movement was good for his age. All three were lovely baby puppies.

Minor Puppy Dog (4)

1. P. Harrison / Skybreaker Not my Circus – Black/Brindle with small white patch on his chest. His bone could be little bit stronger. Lovely clean head, short deep stop, well opened nares and correct bite. Eyes was dark and well place. His ears are well placed, but little bit flighty now. Strong enough neck placed well into nicely angled shoulders. Straight front with good depth of chest and nice wide front. Level topline which he kept on the move with a nice tail carriage. Good front and rear angulations. Moved and presented well.
2. Koendidda Kennels / Koendidda Rhum Dancer – Classy looking black brindle puppy who is very attractive to the eye. He has stronger bone than first placed and his body is more compact. But on the time of the show, his canines were not in the correct position. He is nicely balanced throughout with a pleasing head and shows a nice expression. Front could be wider, his front legs are with too much open feet. Body developing nicely, ample rib for age, straight back, but little bit longer in loin. Level top line and correct tail set. Moved as expected for age but held a nice topline.
3. L. Krevet / Carioris Power N Passion –Black/brindle pup with strong bones. Slightly longer in muzzle with not enoughfeepth of underjaw. Clean head which is nicely shaped with enough stop, dark round eyes end neat well set ears. His head still maturing and has correct bite, tight lips. I prefer little bit more pronounced cheeck muscles. Neat small rose ears. Nice shoulder lay with straight front. Neat well padded feet. Good spring of ribs, not typical straight back little longer in loin, good angulations, his top line is not level in movement and his tail is higher than top line in movement. Moved and handled very well.

Puppy Dog (5,1)

1. C.Heard / Toploader Brundle Hustler – Very handsome 9 m old black/brindle pup where I miss only a little bit stronger bone. Correct head proportions with dark pigmentations, dark round eyes and clean muzzle. Tidy rose ears, short neck flowing into correct shouder with straight well boned front and nice feet. His body is correct proportioned, short coupled with well agnulated rear and good tail set. Level topline which he kept on the move. Handled well.

2. K. Roebig / Bxact Sumthng Wickd Thiswycoms – Another very perspective black/brindle youngster. Stronger bones than the first one, but he is not as balanced as the first one. Pleasing head shows a nice expression. Correct dentition, his underjaw can be stronger. Good stop and dark eyes. Rose ears, strong short neck placed well into his shoulders. Well boned with straight front, but I prefer more width in front. Correct depth of chest. Level top line, short coupled and nicely set tail. Sufficient angulation, moved well both front and rear. Handled well.
3. TJ Amos / Verysharp the Devil Inside – Beautiful short coated black/brindle dog. Shorter in muzzle with some wrinkles, dark nose, correct mouth, dark round eye, definite stop, pronounced cheeks. Broad skull with well-set rose ears. Medium neck with well placed shoulders. Good length of prosternum with width of chest and straight front. Level topline which he kept on the move. Well angulated rear and good tail set. Moved and handled well.

Junior Dog (6)

1. T.&V. Dart / Vagstaff God of Mischief - 15 months old red boy with white blaze. Nice head shape with enough length and deep of muzzle paired with open nares. Neat ears which finish off a nice expression. Bite is correct. Nice strong neck leading down to good depth of brisket and strong shoulders. Level top line and strong rear end with decent bend of stifle. Moved well with drive and held his top line. I just prefer a little bit more masculine strength of bone.
2. J. Rasche / Anvilhart My Bro the Gigolo – Black brindle junior dog with nice head shape, dark eyes and rose ears. Complete and correct bite. Definite stop and enough pronounced cheeks. Broad skull. Good bone, front should be wider. Front pasterns and feet are longer and not strong enough. His ribcage could be wider, straight top line, good angulations and movement.
3. K.Cairns & S. Hanley / Zeraicous Rustic Chief – Young red dog with slightly heavier head and some wrinkles on his muzzle. Good bone. Correct dentition with strong muzzle and underjaw. Rose ears, strong short neck well laid into his shoulders. Level topline, short coupled with nice set tail. Sufficient angulation, moved and handled well.

Intermediate Dog (8,1)

1. M.&J. Sing / Ch. Pranskta The Devil has a Name – Black/brindle dog of good proportions, good strength of bone. Head and skull is correct with broad skull and a distinct stop with very good pigmentation. Excellent mouth with correct bite. His neck is very well muscular and clean in outline, flowing into muscular shoulders. Well padded feet which turned out slightly. Level topline and good spring of rib, hindquarters well angulated. Moved parallel front and back. Presented in great condition and handled expertly. Happy to award him with R.CC
2. S.Clark / Supr. Ch. Capilet Dnt Feed Afta Midnite – Black/brindle dog of good type, but top size. Very well proportioned for his size. Lovely head shape with neat ears and good dark eyes. Muzzle could be just a little bit deeper, but with correct bite and good underjaw. Straight front with good bone and tidy feet, good body when viewed from above. Well sprung ribs, short coupled. Good rear quarters, well muscled. Good coat condition. Moved with purpose.

3. I&L Stanley / Ch. Wildbunch Cosmic Rumble – White/brindle pied taller dog, with not enough bone substance for his height. Lovely head, correct mouth with definite stop. Eyes to coat colour with great pigment and well placed rose ears set. Broad skull with pleasing expression. Good neck that flows and widens to shoulders. Straight in front with nice depth of chest, tight feet, level topline and nicely set tail which he held correctly on the move. Presented in lovely condition and handled well.

Graduate Dog (5,1)

1. K.Roebig / Bxact The soul Taker – Lovely red dog with dark mask and good pigmentation. Correct bite with tight lips, straight well boned front with tight feet. Classic head shape with a keen dark eye, neat ear carriage. Neck muscular, straight front. Well boned with depth of chest. I prefer tighter feet and stronger pasterns. Level top line when stood and on the move. Ribs were well sprung. Good angulations and correct movement.
2. A.Baxter / Boldhart The Devil Strikes Bak – Black/brindle with white, another dog that fits the standard so well. He has a strong head with no excess and an excellent dark mouth pigmentation. Clean tight lips, a strong underjaw, correct dentition with not the correct place of his right canine. Correctly placed neat ears which give him a pleasing expression. He has a straight front, correct depth of brisket and good rib but very short sternum. Strong backend, good turn of stifle and tidy feet, shown in fit hard condition, moved with drive.
3. D&K Crumpton / Jonthill the Coalminer – Very nice white/black pied dog, who fits the standard very well. A little bit on the top of the breed size with not enough bone for his size. Lovely head with very nice expression. Good pigmentation also around his eyes. Dark eyes, neat rose ears, definite stop. Proportioned muzzle, broad skull with good depth of underjaw. Well muscled neck and angulation of shoulders, straight front, good depth of chest. Level topline, his rib should be more rounded ribs. Hindquarters well angulated. Moved parallel front and back.

Limit Dog (9)

1. H.Lomax / Kaleida Lightnin Strikes Twice Jc – Lovely white dog with excellent pigmentation. He is a compact, good sized and well balanced dog with a strong powerful head, strong underjaw, correct bite, dark eyes, neat ears which he use well to create a lovely expression. Strong well boned straight front, shoulders well laid back. Correct pasterns with neat feet, good spring of rib with ample brisket. Compact body shape with level topline, strong well angulated rear end, turned out in good condition, moved and handled well.
2. A.Ireland / Stafflex Heskeys Journey –Black/brindle dog with lots of quality. Well balanced all over. Good head with distinct stop. Black round eyes. Perfect ears. Correct bite but I wish to see on him a little bit stronger underjaw. Straight front, a little bit narrow in front. Neat feet. Good ribcage. Level topline and nice tailset. Short coupled, angulation behind could be more pronounced. Coat in great condition. Moved with good drive and handled very well!
3. Shadowstaff Kennel / Shadowstaff Smooth Criminal – Red dog with white markings on the chest. A head and skull was correct with broad skull and distinct stop. Excellent pigmentation. Correct bite and complete teeth with perfect scissor bite. His skin on head should be more clean. Lovely pigment around muzzle and eye rim. Rose ears giving him a

nice expression. Well muscled neck and angulation of shoulders, straight front, well boned with depth of chest. Short coupled, level top line and good spring of rib. Moved well.

Australian Bred Dog (10)

1. S.Lambert / Ch.Woolloostaff Devils Undeniable – Black brindle dog, smaller, very compact. Good depth of stop and good skull to muzzle ratio. Strong under jaw, correct bite and tight clean lip. Dark round eyes and neat rose ears giving him a perfect expression. Strong pasterns front and rear along with strong and flexible hock. A beautifully balanced dog, on the move showing a level top line.
2. S.Lugg / Borstaff Neverending Story – Very happy white dog with super temperament and always willing to satisfy his owner. His tail wagging all the time. Bigger sized dog with beautiful head and a great expression, rose ear, correct bite, dark round eye. Well boned, good front, Level topline, powerful back end. His top line is not as level as the first one. Anyway he moved with drive and handled well.
3. D&K Edwards / Ch.Sookalott Work of Art –The same type as second, I just prefer better front paws on 2nd. Good type, nothing over done. Good balance, enough compact in all views. Head is enough strong with no loose skin, tidy ears and classic ratio on muzzle to head. Strong muzzle with clean tight lips. Correct bite and strong underjaw. Well laid shoulders, straight front on good legs with a little bit open feet. Well sprung of ribs, level top line and a good underline. Good muscle tone, coat in good condition. He moved soundly.

Open Dog (10)

1. A.Ireland / Ch.Stafflex Taxtime – On my initial look around the class I immediately liked this standard size white dog with black patch on his left side of head. He has a super head that has a wonderful expression, dark round eye, rose ear and correct bite. A well boned straight front, level topline, good bend of stifle, tight feet, and good tail set when standing. He was presented in excellent condition being hard to the touch and a gleaming coat. He moved with drive showing his well developed hindquarters. I was very pleased to awarded him with top honour -dog CC. Well done.
2. Koendidda Kennels / Ch.Koendidda Onya Birri – Another white standard sized male with black markings on his head and body. He is little bit more elegant than the first one. Excellent head with complete and corect bite. Lovely head shape with correct lenght of muzzle, strong underjaw, distinct stop and dark eyes. Nice rose ears, good neck and well alid shoulders. Good depth of chest, nice level topline and pump handle tail. Moved well from front and rear – handled well in good contition.
3. A&D Major / Aust.ch.Kabere Rock Paper Scissors – I like this black/brindle boy very much. He showed his proper size with good balance. Exceptional beautiful head, I just prefer some more mouth pigmentation. Nice bone with good shoulder placement and straight in front. Nice width and depth of brisket. Short coupled, very well angulated behind. Unfortunately in movement his top line is not level and he showed a sloped crope,especially in movement.

Baby Puppy Bitch (8)

1. G.Brooks / Cyprustaff Justlikethis – Lighter red baby puppy bitch with white collar and white chest. Very promising puppy. Her head is perfect for her age, very feminine with nice expression. Dark eyes with great pigmentation. Nicely proportioned throughout. Straight front and level top line which she held on move. Well angulated. Moved well for a baby.
2. J.Chivers / Vagastaff Gayles Gift – Deeper red than first, with just small white patterns on her chest. Another very promising puppy with amazing pigment, showing off a beautiful deep rich red colour. Lovely clean head. Correct mouth for a baby of her age. Dark eyes. Wonderful straight front and bone with small tight feet. Level topline, angulation behind could be better, moved well.
3. K.Coulson / Lilrock Never da Devil – Lovely proportioned black/brindle baby with small white patch on her chest. Head was clean, developing. Ears are neat, muzzle correct in length with correct scissor bite. Good width to front with lovely tight feet, strong powerful neck following through to well laid back shoulders, close-coupled. Top line is not level, especially in movement. A little bit short and sloped in croup. Moved well.

Minor Puppy Bitch (2)

1. C.Heard / Toploader Black Chrome – Beautiful black/brindle puppy bitch, I can easily say without any mistakes. She is nicely balanced with correct head. Good strong foreface of good length of muzzle. Having the correct ratio to skull, dark round eye and nicely placed and tidy ear carriage. She has a good straight front on good tight feet. Her ribcage is adequate at this stage of her development. She has correct depth of brisket. Her movement was good and showed a good topline on the move. She just needs a few more outings to settle her in the ring, but moved well front and rear. Very happy to award her with Best Minor puppy in show.
2. D&K.Edwards / Sookalott Light my Way – Very similar black/brindle bitch to the first one. Nicely proportioned head with tight clean lips, good dentition and sufficient stop. Dark eyes with lovely expression, rose set ears. Clean neck widening to shoulders with good angulation. Straight front with lovely tight feet. Sufficient bone and good spring of ribs, close coupled. Her topline is not as level as the first in movement, topline slightly dropping to tail set and carried well.

Puppy Bitch (5)

1. K.Roebig / Bxact the Knockout – Lovely red puppy bitch with white on her chest, liked her a lot, very well balanced. Head is well proportioned with good strong muzzle and correct bite, definite stop, broad and deep skull with lovely placed rose ears. Neck of correct length and good shoulder placement. Well boned, enough wide and straight front, only the paws are little bit too flat and I prefer tighter toes. Good depth of chest and lovely spring of ribs for her age. Nice tuck up and level topline. Moved well front and rear, stifles well bent.
2. C.Heard / Toploader Velvetrevolver – Smart black/brindle bitch, there was not much between the 1st and 2nd places. This girl also has a lovely head shape, strong underjaw with correct dentition and no lippiness. Good stop, pronounced cheek muscles, broad skull. Ears are little bit too high on her skull. Correct length of clean neck, well placed shoulders, but

she is little bit loose in elbows, which I can see in her movement. Straight front and nice tight feet. Level topline with spring of ribs, good angulation in hindquarters. Moved well, shown in good condition and handled well.

3. T.J. Amos / Verysharp Read my Future – The black/brindle bitch, which I liked very much. If she will be in older class, can be my winner anytime. She is so perfect for puppy girl – too perfect to be real. A big size, but in balance and all correct proportions. Dark pigmentation, strong muzzle, correct dentition. Definite stop with eyes to suit coat colour. Lovely ear placement and set. Straight in front and adequate width. Tight feet, level topline and nice tail set that carried well, also in movement.

Junior Bitch (9)

1. Koendidda Kennels / Jonthill Buckle Up Buttercup – This deep red girl just stole my heart. Everything about this girl made me look at her, I liked everything about her, very classy. She is clean in all departments, plenty of bone and rib, her head shaped and expression is right. Good length of muzzle with good strength of under jaw. She has a good bend of stifle with good padded feet. Correct wide front with a lovely side profile. She moved with power and drive from a strong muscled back end, keeping her topline. I believe that when she will mature, she will have a bright future. With big pleasure I was awarded her with Best Junior Iofshow, CC & BIS.
2. J. Rasche / Aust. Ch. Anvilhart What you Wish for – Another beautiful black/brindle bitch with white chest, her head is simply perfect for me. She is top size, but compact enough and in balance. Even though she is top size, she looks feminine. Her head suits on her well balanced body. Distinct stop and correct bite. Dark eyes with lovely expression and nice rose ears carriage. Good shoulders, straight front and good depth of brisket. Her front legs are enough wide apart, but feet are too flat for my opinion. Nice spring of ribs with level top line. Good hindquarter angulation. Moved and handled well.
3. D&K. Edwards / Sookalott the Spy Who Luvd Me – Black/brindle bitch with small white spot on her chest. Strong clean head, good strong underjaw and correct dentition. Dark round eyes, ear set is correct. Strong and powerful neck widening to nice shoulder angulation. Strong front with good bone and very nice tight feet. Good depth of brisket and spring of ribs, nicely tucked up with level topline, well angulated hindquarters, slightly longer in loin. Moved and handled well.

Intermediate Bitch (8,1)

1. Anvilhart kennels / Anvilhart Oopsie Whoopsie – Very nice and correct fawn bitch with lovely dark mask and very dark eyes, who fits the standard very well. A finer girl but all in proportion. Correct head, strong muzzle with good deep underjaw. Definite stop, the pigmentation around her eyes gave her an amazing expression. Nice width of skull and good depth. Lovely rose ears. Good shoulders with a straight and enough wide front, good depth of brisket. Level topline and pump handle tail. Strong hindquarters with sufficient angulation. Presented and handled well.
2. F. McBride / Ch. Brohez Queens Gambit – Black/brindle bitch with small white patches on her chest. Very well balanced girl with good proportions. Standing square and in good condition. Head enough strong but still feminine with correct dentition. Good open nares,

definite stop. Rose ears are placed little bit higher on her skull. Dark eyes. Strong short neck placed well into well angulated shoulders. Good straight front and well boned with lovely tight feet. Level topline, short coupled with nice tuck up. Well developed hindquarters with good angulation. Moved and handled well.

3. A.Dean&G.Bator / Ch.Handpikd Miss Bombay – White with black markings, of taller size. Broad skull with good length of muzzle, which can be more deep and wide. Good pigmentation. Dark eyes, scissor bite, clean muzzle. Rose ears little bit higher on the top of the skull, muscular and clean neck. Wide straight front with good brisket. Level topline, short coupled. Good spring of rib, well angulated in front and behind. Hocks well let down. Moved well.

Graduate Bitch (4,1)

1. D&K.Crumpton / Jonthill Winnie Wildfire – Deep red well balanced bitch with white chest and white front socks. She has beautiful headshape, gorgeous expression with dark mask and very dark eyes. Her length of muzzle is just perfect with excellent strong underjaw. Good reach of neck, strength in bone, front could be wider. Deep brisket, level topline, held on the move, good bend of stifle, good rear angulation and correct tail carriage. Moved with ease, handled well. Strong contender for higher honours. Happy to awarded her with Best Graduate in show.
2. E.Lomax / Usherin Whats Poppin – Black/brindle bitch with white chest, similar to the first one, but with lighter bone. Good head, neat ears, dark eye, lips tight enough, would like a bit more underjaw. Good width of chest and depth of brisket, strong legs, strength of pasterns and neat feet with dark nails. Decent rib, her rear quarters are ok. She was happy enough moving in the ring carrying her tail correctly.
3. G.Brooks / Cyprustaff Sweet N Sassy – Light fawn bitch with not dark enough pigmentation on her head. Her nose is gray. All the rest on her fit the standard very well. Good size, very well propotional girl. Her head fits to her body very well, correct bite, dark eyes. She has a straight front, good width and depth of chest, Ample bone and lovely feet. Short in neck, plenty of rib flowing back into a super tight loin and well-musclcd rear quarters, she moved out really well holding a good top line.

Limit Bitch (7)

1. K.Roebig / Bxact Shake Datazz Forme – Another lovely dark red bitch with white chest and dark mask. Lovely head shape with distinct stop, ears correctly placed with correct bite, just prefer stronger underjaw. Good pigmentation, front straight and plenty of bone showing no weakness at pasterns and good feet. Topline level when stacked and on the move. Well balanced bitch with a nice bend of stifle, short coupled, handled well. Shown in great condition. Happy to award her with Best limit in Show.
2. SJ.Wymark / Savion Smokin Hot – Black/brindle bitch, another with lots of quality. Broad head and great stop, lovely ears and dark eyes, correct bite and good underjaw, good cheek bumps, well laid-back shoulders front. Straight and lots of bone with good depth of brisket, neat feet, short coupled and level topline with a nice tuck up, well bend to stifle and good musclcd hocks, coat short, moved well in the ring, and shown in a fit condition.

3. K.Coulson / Lilrock Devils Calling JC – A standard black brindle bitch with small white spot on her chest. Slightly finer than first two, but anyway in very good balance overall. Pleasing head shape, dark expressive eyes. Correct bite and dentition, not enough mouth pigmentation. Well-proportioned body, good front and feet, movement good both ways parallel. Nicely made with good tail carriage.

Australian Bred Bitch (13,2)

1. Anvilhart Kennels / Ch.Anvilhart Canya Keepa Secret – Lovely black/brindle bitch with white chest on the top size, but very balanced for her size. Lovely head piece with complete scissor bite, strong underjaw, tight lips, round dark eyes with good pigmentation and keen feminine expression. Her skull is deep throughout with correct small rose ears. Well laidback shoulders, straight front with tight padded feet. Good bones, good depth of brisket. Well tucked up and short coupled. Level topline with good tail set. Well muscled hindquarters with good angulations, hocks well let down. Moved with drive and kept her topline level all the time. Awarded her with Best Australian in show.
2. A.Dean&G.Bator / Ch.Handpikd Queen of Diamonds – White/black pied standard bitch in good proportion. Smaller than first with little bit lighter bone than first one. Feminine head with correct bite, deep stop and enough depth of muzzle. Dark round eye, pronounced cheek muscles, rose ears. Strong neck, well placed shoulders. Well boned, straight front and good prosternum with nice depth of brisket. Level top line and correct angulations. Moved and handled well.
3. A.Ireland / Stafflex Clash of Hearts – Lovely black/brindle bitch with white spots on chest and feet. Very clean in the head, clearly feminine, neat rose ears which she uses well, dark well-placed eye and good bite. Pleasing front which shows width and depth of brisket. Good upper arm placement and tidy feet. She holds a level topline on the move and has good angulation to front and rear. Moved and handled well.

Open Bitch (7,3)

1. A&D.Major / Aust.sup.Ch.Kabere Yamademegofullninja – Black/brindle enough strength, muscular bitch of good size with nice proportions. Very feminine head with scissor bite, distinct stop and lovely dark eyes. Broad skull with good depth and nicely placed rose ears. Presenting a good blend of bull and terrier, she has a straight front of good angulations, no weakness at pasterns, tidy feet, good length of upper arm and ample spring of rib. Moved perfect and presented in tip top condition. Very happy to awarded her with Best Open in show, R.CC and R.BIS
2. F.McBride / Ch.Brohez Satin Doll – Another lovely black/brindle bitch with white spot on her chest. Lovely strong head with correct dentition. Dark nose and open nares. Distinct stop, dark eyes. Correctly placed small rose ears, pronounced cheek muscles, in my opinion just a little bit too much skin under her neck. Nicely laid shoulders with straight front with nice padded and tight feet. Good spring of ribs, level top line, short compact body. Level topline, correct tail set, good angulations and movement.
3. A.Dean&G.Bator / Ch.Handpikd the Duchess – Correct black/brindle bitch with white spot on her chest. She is little bit lighter in bone but anyway balanced enough. Feminine head with

good proportions, dark eyes, complete dentition with a strong underjaw. Deep stop giving her correct placement of dark eyes. Skull deep with pronounced cheek muscles. Strong short neck with well laid shoulders. Straight front and tight feet, deep brisket. Level topline, little longer in loin. Moves sound.

Neuter Dog (4,1)

1. D.Treadwell / Neut.Ch.Kimbastaff Doo in it Solo – Black/brindle dog with good pigmentation. Short coupled, nice correct head with correct mouth, good length of muzzle, neat rose ears. Straight front, he held his level topline on the move with a correct tail set. Happy to awarded him with Best Neuter in show.
2. N.May / Kimbastaff Creating Kaos – Black/brindle dog with white chest in good condition. Nice shaped head. Dark round eyes, good cheeks and correct stop. He has enough bone to balance, good width to his front and a good sized rib cage. Correct movement and angulation. On the day of the show he was just a little bit too nervous.
3. S.Lambert / Ch.Neut.Ch.Woolloostaff The Devils Envy – Black/brindle dog with excellent head. Enough bone for his height. Correct head proportions with lovely dark eyes, which gave him very pleasant expression. His front is wide enough and correct. The back part of the dog is not balanced with first part, so he looks little bit two-part. Anyway his movement is ok, just his topline is not level in movement. Angulation behind could be better.

Neuter Bitch (5,1)

1. S.Clark&K.Coulson / Ch.Neut.Ch.Lilrock Canny Lass – Black/brindle bitch of good proportions. Correct head with clean muzzle. Distinct stop with rose ears and dark eyes. Good strong neck, straight and wide front. Well padded tight feet. Level topline which she kept on the move. Good muscled hindquarters. Correct movement.
2. D&F.Lowe / Aust.Sup.&Neut.Ch.Seighford Luna Lovedog – White bitch with black patch on her left eye. Little bit lighter bone than first. Has a strong head with good pigment and very dark eyes. Clean muzzle with enough strong underjaw. Rose ears, good depth of skull. Strong neck, straight front with not tight enough feet. Good depth of brisket, level topline with good angulations. Moved well and did not lose her topline.
3. B.Dixon / Kaleida Get the Party Started – White bitch with black pigmentation. Finer type of bitch, very pretty head, clean with a good stop and short strong muzzle. Nice eye and well carried ears. A correct bite. She has just enough bone for her size, a good topline and she moved well, I would prefer better angulation behind.
