

## **2022 – 2023 ANNUAL ELECTIONS**

In accordance with Rules 40 and 41 of the Constitution, nominations are hereby called for Office Bearers and Members of the Committee of the Schnauzer Club of New South Wales Inc. for the year 2022-2023.

The Constitution provides for the following methods of voting:-

- (a) by post – or
- (b) at the Annual General Meeting to be held on Wednesday, 3<sup>rd</sup> August, 2022 at the Dundas Ermington Uniting Church Hall, 181 Park Rd, Dundas (cnr of Kissing Point Rd and Park Rd) at 7:30pm.

Any member desirous of exercising a Postal Vote **MUST APPLY** for a ballot paper at least 21 days prior to the Annual General Meeting, i.e., **YOUR APPLICATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE SECRETARY NO LATER THAN WEDNESDAY, 13<sup>TH</sup> JULY, 2022.** Accompanying this application for a Postal Vote must be a stamped addressed envelope for the mailing of the Ballot Paper. When returning the Postal Vote the member voting must endorse his/her name on the inside flap of the envelope forwarded by the Secretary and return such envelope properly sealed to arrive at the Club's Office not later than 5:00pm (which shall be the time of closing of the Postal Ballot) of the day appointed for the holding of the Annual General Meeting.

### **ELIGIBILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ELECTION**

Only financial members of the Club (i.e. Paid dues for the year 2022-2023 and Life Members) are eligible to –

- Nominate a candidate
- Stand for office
- Vote in the Election.

To be financial members, renewal fees must be paid by 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2022.

### **NOMINATIONS**

Nominations must be in writing, signed by the nominee and nominator. A financial member may nominate candidates for any or all positions vacant. Closing date for receipt of nominations is **WEDNESDAY, 13<sup>TH</sup> JULY, 2022** with:
