CODE OF CONDUCT

Members:

I will:

- Always treat other members of the Southern Cross Staffordshire Bull Terrier Society (referred to as the “club” for the remainder of this document) with respect
- Always ensure the health and welfare of my dogs
- Participate in club activities for my own enjoyment and benefit
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all club members regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion
- Raise any concerns I have about owners with the appropriate authorities if I suspect abuse or neglect of any animal(s)
- Comply with local authority rules in relation to the health and welfare of my dogs and ensure they are not a nuisance
- Ensure I have obtained professional advice before breeding my Staffordshire Bull Terrier – preferably adhering to the current Litter Registration Limitation Scheme (LRL) regulations, including but not limited to DNA health testing.
- Ensure I take full responsibility of any litters should I decide to breed in relation to any of the above

I will not:

- Exhibit any behaviour, online or otherwise that contributes to the negative perception of the Staffordshire Bull Terrier breed, DogsNZ, The Southern Cross Staffordshire Bull Terrier Society or its membership.
- Allow any mistreatment of dogs and any such incident shall be reported to the DogsNZ / NZKC and/or local authorities where appropriate
- Use bad language, nor will I harass club members, prospective members or members of the committee
- Breed my dog(s) irresponsibly, without ensuring the health and welfare of any future litters.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Committee:

I will:

- Abide by the rules set out by the constitution of the Southern Cross Staffordshire Bull Terrier Society (referred to as the “club” for the remainder of this document)
- Display professional and fair behaviour at all times whilst representing the club
- Remember that members participate for their enjoyment and benefit
- Ensure that everyone involved in the club emphasises positive representation of the Staffordshire Bull Terrier
- Ensure that all club members are treated equally and fairly and are given correct information relating to their dogs
- Help other members of the committee highlight appropriate behaviour, and help to improve and promote the club
- Distribute a code of conduct to all new members and encourage them to follow it
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all members involved in the club, regardless of their gender, ability or cultural background
- Promote adherence to the ongoing welfare of the Staffordshire Bull Terrier
- Provide information about breeding and de-sexing when requested to encourage the appropriate continuation of the Staffordshire Bull Terrier

I will not:

- Exhibit any behaviour, online or otherwise that contributes to the negative perception of the Staffordshire Bull Terrier breed.
- Allow any mistreatment of dogs and any such incident shall be reported to DogsNZ and or local authorities where appropriate
- Use bad language, nor will I harass club members, prospective members or members of the committee
- Use my position as a member of the committee to promote my own personal opinions or financial gain/business ventures
