POINT SCORE RULES

PERSONS ELIGIBLE

All persons participating in this Point Score must be financial members of The Great Dane Club of NSW Inc. NOTE: Where a Great Dane is in co-ownership, then ALL owners must be financial members of The Great Dane Club of NSW Inc. If a dog is in co-ownership with an Interstate person but all NSW residence are financial members, this dog is also permitted to enter the Point Score.

SHOWS ELIGIBLE

- Any Championship Show held in NSW or the ACT, except for those shows listed below under “Shows Ineligible”.
- The National Great Dane Specialty Show, where awards for Best of Breed, Runner Up to Best of Breed and the usual Puppy Classes are included.

SHOWS INELIGIBLE

- The Sydney Royal Easter Show.
- Any Show held on the same day as a show of The Great Dane Club of NSW Inc, except where said Show is held in conjunction with a Show of The Great Dane Club of NSW Inc.

RECORDING OF POINTS

- Your dog’s two best Show results, per class, for each month are to be submitted to the Point Score Keeper.
- Your dog’s full registered name (if call name is different), and the points awarded are to be clearly marked on the front cover of each catalog and the Great Dane section of the catalog to be fully marked.
- The front cover of each catalog and the Great Dane section of the catalog to be submitted to the Point Score Keeper **no later** than the 15th day of the following month.
- No limitation will be made if your dog’s best results are awarded by a Judge who you have already used.
- Points gained for the Great Dane of The Year may only come from Minor Puppy classes up.
- At the conclusion of the year, the Point Score Keeper will deduct each dog’s lowest points for two months from those submitted, to give a tally of 10 month’s points. This may vary as voted on by club members under unusual circumstances ie: Covid 19.
- Updated and final results to be posted in The Great Dane Club of NSW Inc Facebook Group and/or emailed to club members.
- Final results to be uploaded to The Great Dane Club of NSW Inc. web page.

POINT SCORE

To determine the Great Dane of the Year and the Top Ten of the Year, points are derived from breed judging (Group and All Breed in Show awards are not allowable).

Points will be awarded on a one-for-one basis, plus one point for yourself. This applies to the first three (3) place getters.

EXAMPLE

20 Great Danes entered and shown (from Minor Puppy upwards), BOB gains 20 points, RUBOB gains 19 points. A dog is placed second (2nd) in a class of five (5) dogs. He gains four (4) points. The dogs placed third (3rd) gains three (3) points. Opposite points can only be gained from Best of Class wins. (If a “non” Reserve Challenge winning dog wins over a Reserve Challenge winning dog in the Class run-off, then the winner gains all those reserve points as well).

FEEES

\$5.00 per dog. All monies are to be paid to the Treasurer. New and/or extra dogs may be added at any time during the year and will enter the Point Score from the following month forward (eg Ch Fido’s notification received on September 4. Dog enters Point Score with October points).

TROPHIES

Trophies to be coordinate through Point Score Keeper & Trophy Steward.

Trophies to be in proportion to number of entries: up to 15 entries Top 3 receive photo trophies
16 – 30 Top 5 receive photo trophies
30+ Top 10 to receive photo trophies

Best Pup, Junior & Neuter to receive photo trophies

For those that finish outside of the Top Bracket who wish to receive Photo Trophies, they may do so at their own expense.
