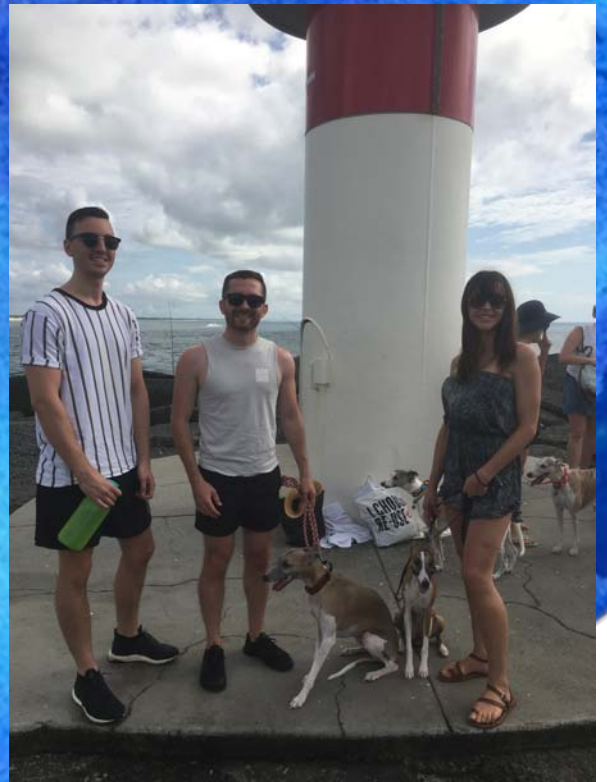
WHIPPET CLUB FUN DAY!!!

Follow up on Andrea Raflesath enquiry about rehoming her female whippet Ollie. I was able to place her into a whippet savvy home with a male whippet Eddie. Ollie was very stressed but settled in quickly and is now a happy whippet in a happy whippet home.

My darling oldies Wogi and Molly have gone to live with another whippet and dachshund in Brisbane. I get to see them regularly and Wogi came back to us for a month while he had ongoing vet treatment.

Whippets in Need Aust contacted me about a lady in Bris needing to rehome her young entire male whippet. Aspen needed a home with someone home more often than not and an owner who understood the breed. He has a lovely home now with other dog company and a grandma who home all day while the rest of the extended family are at work and school. He is now desexed and has settled quickly. 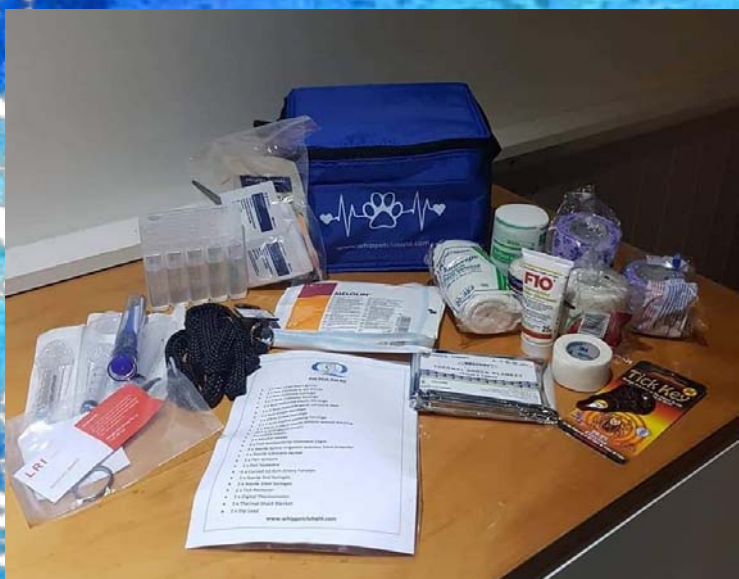

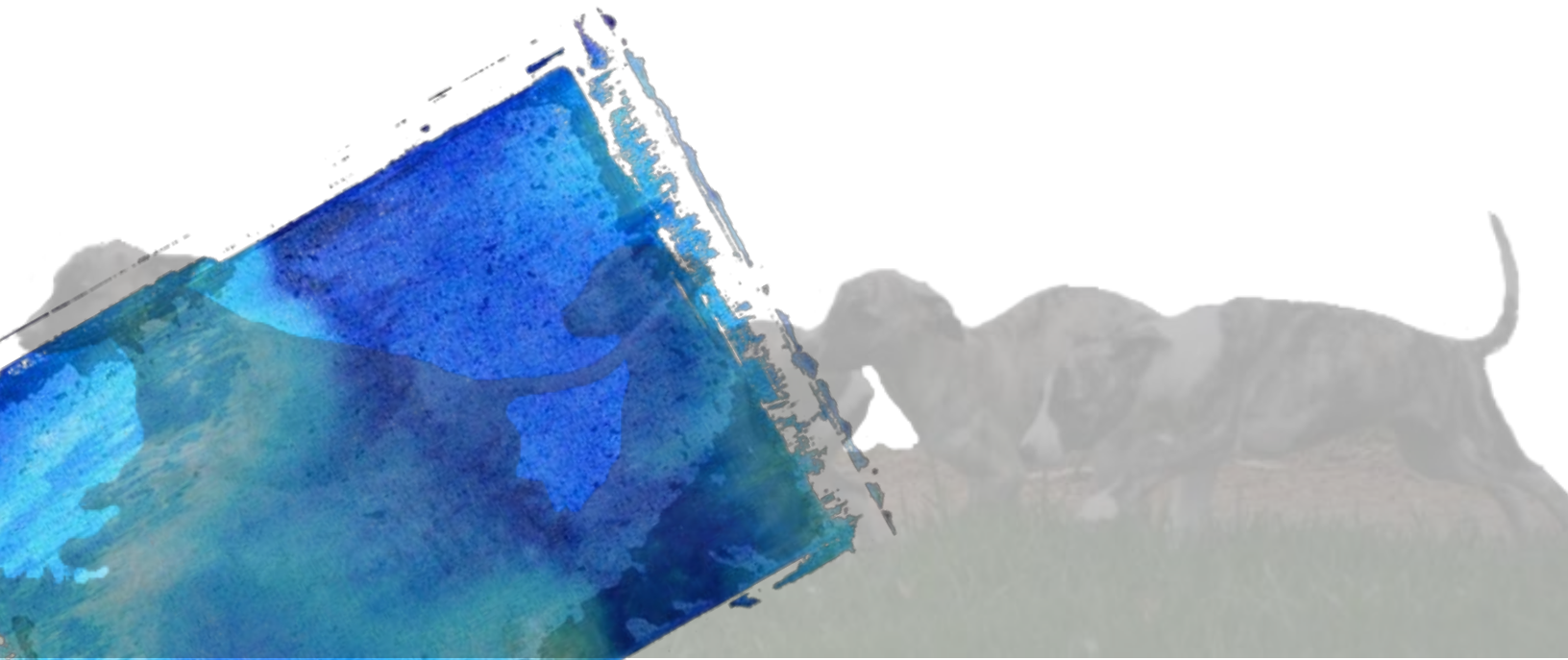
