I have judged extensively throughout Ireland and the UK, as well as across Europe including Finland, Germany, Sweden, Switzerland and Belgium.

I am lucky to be born into a family of animal lovers. Over 90 champions have now been bred or owned in various breeds worldwide since the Barnesmore affix was originally registered in the late sixties. We have now produced over 60 whippet champions including champions in 10 different countries worldwide. I have bred and owned many multi champion whippets, Greyhounds & Ibizan Hounds, as well as campaigning my Borzois to their Irish/International & UK titles. I was honoured to





have won the CC & Best of Breed at Crufts with my whippet bitch some years ago and then watch with delight to see her homebred son take the CC at Crufts handled by my mother a few years later.

I am a member of the Whippet Club (N.I), Greyhound Club (UK) and the Ibizan Club (UK), and was previously a Committee Member of the English Ibizan Hound Club, as well as having been Chairperson of the N.I Whippet Club. I have stewarded from the age of twelve and been involved in exhibiting since the age of four. I thoroughly enjoy judging and showing, especially the delight and joy my dogs give me, in and out of the show ring.

## *The Venue*

The 6<sup>th</sup> Australian Whippet National Championship Show will be held at SACA Park, Cromwell Road, Kilburn.

David Roche Park is centrally located and easy to find. It is situated on Cromwell Road which runs between Prospect and Churchill Roads.

There is ample parking available close to the show rings. There are two entrances to the grounds, however it would be more convenient for exhibitors to enter at the main entrance that leads into the paved car parking area and drive down to the car parking area in closer proximity to the rings.

You are welcome to set up canopies nearby the ring, but please remember there will be a significant number of exhibitors. We are expecting a large number of overseas visitors as well as sponsors and will provide some seating near the ring for their convenience

### ***Adelaide, South Australia - The wine capital of Australia***

There are over 200 cellar doors on Adelaide's doorstep. Adelaide is the wine capital of Australia. We're sure you've heard of the Barossa. There is so much to explore, including McLaren Vale, the Adelaide Hills, Coonawarra and more

South Australia has 16 distinct wine regions. Two or more wine regions are often grouped together. It's almost as if it was designed to make it easy for you to do a grand winery tour! Here's a quick rundown of Australia's wine capital

#### **Adelaide and Adelaide Plains**

home to wineries like Penfolds. You'll find the National Wine Centre of Australia in Adelaide. It's a great place to learn about wine. You'll discover cellar doors and tasting rooms in and around Adelaide city, giving you plenty of wine tasting opportunities

#### **The Adelaide Hills**

Just a short drive from Adelaide city, the [Adelaide Hills](#) is a great place to spend a day touring cellar doors. If you "fall" for one cellar door, camp out on rolling lawns or in front of a fireplace for the afternoon.

#### **Barossa**

Two wine regions combined make up the Barossa. Each area has its speciality in wines. [Eden Valley](#) has a reputation for amazing Riesling. [The](#)

[Barossa Valley](#) is home to some of the world's best Shiraz.

#### Clare Valley

[Clare Valley](#) is a little further north from the Barossa. Clare Valley is famous for Riesling and you'll know why once you try it. Follow the Riesling Trail by bicycle and stop at cellar doors to try some of this well made "drop".

#### Fleurieu Peninsula

[McLaren Vale](#), [Langhorne Creek](#), [Currency Creek](#) and [Southern Fleurieu](#) are all wine regions on the Fleurieu Peninsula, south of Adelaide. You'll be spoilt for choice with this array of excellent cellar doors. Keep an eye out. You may find a "brewery door" or two as well!

#### Kangaroo Island

Stop at a [Kangaroo Island](#) cellar door or a distillery for tasty liqueurs. Wherever you are on the island, you'll be near a winery that will please your taste buds

#### Limestone Coast

[Coonawarra](#), [Padthaway](#), [Mount Benson](#) and [Wrattonbully](#) are on the Limestone Coast. The Limestone Coast is renowned for great, robust wines, thanks to its unique terra rossa soil (soil that gives the grapes a special flavour due to the limestone layers). You'll want to taste wines from Wynn's Coonawarra Estate, Zema Estate and Hollick Wines in the Coonawarra. Try more wines from Padthaway Estate Winery, Mt Benson Premium Estate Wines, Cape Jaffa and Russett Ridge.

#### The Riverland

[The Riverland](#) is located on the Murray River. It is home to some well-known and loved wineries. Visit Berri Estate, Banrock Station Wine and Wetlands Centre and Angove's Family Winemakers. There is a Riverland Wine and Food Trail Map to help you discover the great wines of the area.

#### Southern Flinders Ranges

The [Southern Flinders](#) wine region produces some surprising wines. Places like Remarkable Wines, Bundaleer Wines (tastings at the North Star Hotel) and Bartagunyah Estate have an exciting array of wines for you to taste

### ***Go to the Zoo***

Visit the giant pandas at Adelaide Zoo. Their names are Wang Wang (male) and Funi (female), the only giant pandas in the southern hemisphere. You can even take a behind the scenes tour and help prepare their bamboo breakfast.

### ***Then..***

Catch your breath in our beautiful parks and gardens. Adelaide Botanic Garden is a haven in the heart of the city

Take the tram to Glenelg.

### ***Head for the hills***

Take a day trip to Hahndorf, one of the Adelaide Hills' most famous towns. It's Australia's oldest surviving settlement and has a strong German



heritage. Stop at nearby Cleland Wildlife Park to feed kangaroos and hold a koala.

A trip to the Mount Lofty Summit to experience the spectacular views of the Adelaide Plains and surrounding area including Kangaroo Island and Yorke Peninsula is not to be missed.

Visit Melba's Chocolate Factory at Woodside then hop along to the Giant Rocking Horse and Toy Factory at Gumeracha. The National Motor Museum is just up the road at Birdwood.

### ***Hit the beach***

Relax on a beautiful beach. Catch a tram from Adelaide to Glenelg for some fun in the sun. Enjoy al fresco dining on Jetty Road or Holdfast Marina.

Go fishing on the Eyre Peninsula. Feast on oysters, lobsters and abalone. Dive in and swim with wildlife. Enjoy the antics of sea lions and the thrill of great white sharks.

### ***Visit our National Landscapes***

Admire nature on Kangaroo Island. Visit Remarkable Rocks and Admirals Arch - these rock formations are incredible! See native animals thriving in the wild, like seals at Seal Bay. Explore stunning beaches and desert dunes.

See rock art, fossils and spectacular landscapes in the Flinders Ranges. Get a bird's eye view of Wilpena Pound on a scenic flight.

### ***Head down the coast***

Stop by the seaside town of Victor Harbor. Cross the causeway on a horse-drawn tram and see little penguins on Granite Island. Visit the South Australian Whale Centre or board the Cockle Train for a steam train ride.
