## ∞ Remembering Yvonne Simpson ∞

8 August 1944 – 16 August 2005

Yvonne Simpson was the YTCNSW Club Secretary for approximately 17 years. Yvonne was ever-welcoming and nothing was too much trouble for her. She always had time to help anyone and everyone. Towards the end of 2003 Yvonne revealed the extent of her illness. She went to hospital in January 2004 and never came out. She put up a mighty fight, sustained by her profound and unquestioning faith.

Yvonne wasn't well off, but she would have given her last penny and the shirt off her back, if she thought someone needed it. She was always a giver, sometimes to her detriment. People considered her a bit of a muddler at times, but this was probably because she spent so much of her time and energy helping others.

Yvonne was nominated for Life Membership towards the end of her service as Club Secretary.

Always rest in peace Yvonne, like so many others now - gone, but not forgotten.
